For those of you who do not have a box of envelopes, please fill out the “New Parishioner” section in the bulletin and drop it in the collection basket or call me at the office during office hours.

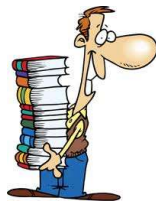
