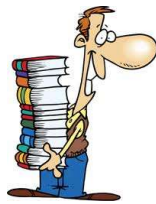


The IHM CWL is hosting a presentation on **Estate Planning**, and there are two dates to choose from, **Saturday 16th February** after the **9:00 Mass** AND

Gently used paperbacks are welcome. No need for harcovers.

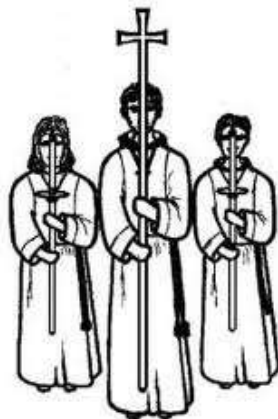
Come one, come all! Coffee is served.
