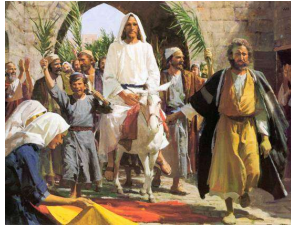

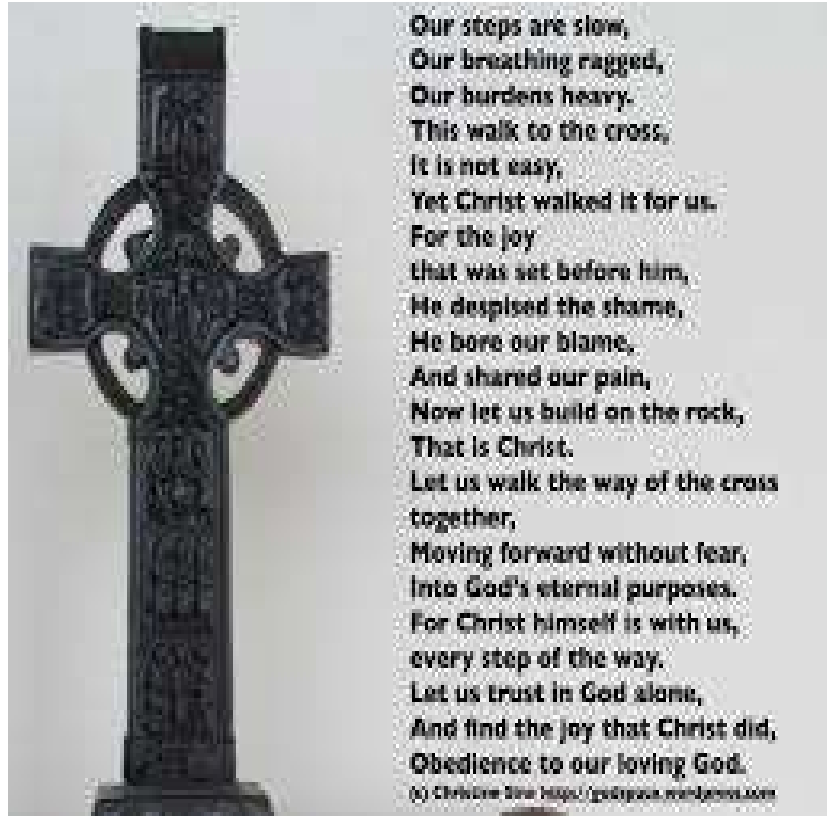
## **HIKE FOR LIFE**

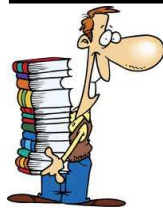
Church Refurbishing update:
