



Children's Ministry Policy

In order to continue to offer a safe and welcoming place for the children of New Life and the community. We will be implementing the following policies to insure a healthy and secure environment for the well-being of our children:

1. Check-in policy

Children must be signed in by an adult, parent, or guardian. There will be a sign in sheet where we will ask for your name, your child's name, and your signature and contact information. Children will only be allowed to participate if signed in first.

2. Check-out policy

A child may not be released until the same adult, parent or guardian that sign the child in, is the same adult, parent or guardian that comes to sign the child out with a few exceptions which can be viewed below.

3. Two-adult rule

It shall be the that a minimum of two workers will be in attendance at all times when children are being supervised during a church activity, regardless of the number of participants, location or activity.

4. Bathroom Policy

Two volunteers are required to take children to the restrooms. One volunteer will check the restroom before the child enters. Both volunteers should remain outside the restroom to wait for the child.

5. Permission slips

Any and all activity that take the child off church grounds will be preceded by a permission slip. A child will only be able to participate in said event if permission slip is signed by an adult, parent, or guardian and received by the church prior to event, no exceptions.

Please Note

We understand here at New Life that there are times that we all run late. When running late, we welcome you and are glad you are here but you still need to sign your child in to participate in the events. Please remind the child to enter the class room respectfully for there could be prayers, pledges, and activities taking place.

If you could please assist your child with any bathroom issues before entering the classroom. This would be a great time saver for us and a help to our volunteers.

New Life Assembly of God will make allowances' for adults, parents, and guardians to drop off their child and have a different adult, parent, or guardian pick them up. In such cases New Life Assembly of God will need the adult, parent, or guardian (the one signing in the child) to write a letter to New Life identifying the individual that will be picking up the child. Please give the letter to the worker's when signing the child in.

We will not allow children to walk home by themselves or with siblings unless they are adults and are able to sign the child in and out.

Thank you for working with New Life Assembly of God to keep our children safe and secure.
