70.16	CORRESPONDENCE MK reminded Committee members that they had signed the Code of Conduct.	



73.16	<p>HON SECRETARY’S REPORT</p> <p>EB has been on site for the 60th setup and has not had the membership numbers to date but will update at the next meeting.</p> <p>EB thought that the silver plaques she had recently receiving looked to be of very good quality.</p>	EB

AC asked if we query why people don’t show. MK said these should be followed up.</p> <p>DH reported that some stewards are still spending the VAT on the rally social. 75.16	<p>HON RALLY SECRETARY’S REPORT</p> <p>No report as the Rally Secretary was not at the meeting.</p> <p>AH had offered his resignation, which was accepted by the committee earlier in the meeting. For the remainder of the year MS offered to step into the Rally Sec’s role, which the committee accepted.</p>	
76.16	<p>60th ANNIVERSARY RALLY</p> <p>Update: Bookings are lower than hoped and expected with 51 units having booked to date. MK met with Derek Philp on 14th April. Driving and reversing going ahead. Martin Eastley has obtained a caravan for us to use. Janice and Paul Featherstone have been notified. Thanks to Martin and Carole Eastley for the caravan. Due to the reduced numbers the bouncy castle has had to be removed. Martin and Catherine King have bought a bouncy castle of their own and are hoping to be able to use this over the weekend. This will be strictly supervised and there will be a disclaimer. SA asked if he thought this was sufficient after recent events. MK stressed it will be firmly pegged down, will be strictly controlled and supervised and will not be put up if there is any wind at all. SA will try to get some weights to help with holding down. MK reported that we have lost the deposit of £105 paid for the additional marquee section and today he had an issue with the firm we were hiring the generator from so he has had to hire another generator from a different source.</p>	SA
