A Word from our Executive Director

We have been able to accomplish so much with so little. Just imagine who we could help and the lives we could change if we had just a 50% increase in income!

As we approach Thanksgiving and Christmas our hearts are often turned outwards. We strive to find ways to serve others in different ways than we have throughout the year. With so many wonderful charities and organizations serving the community it can be difficult to choose who to help. *This year I am inviting you to choose PSIC.*

Over the past year, PSIC has changed and grown in so many ways. There is no part that has remained the same since 2015. We have many new volunteers and board members. Every person that has joined our ministry has brought their own unique perspectives, ideas, and talents. I am extremely grateful for all of the staff, board members, and supporters of PSIC. *There is no way that this ministry could serve so many without each person, each dollar, and each prayer.*

Donations received in 2016 were collected and used for many projects. Thanks to our volunteer's time and money we were able to completely rejuvenate the interior of the office. Our clients have commented on how professional and relaxing our atmosphere is now. We have been able to purchase 21 new Earn While You Learn classes to help our clients reach their parenting goals. New software enables us to help clients on any day of the week, even when we are not open. Over 7,800 diapers were given to clients. All material donations were sorted, cleaned, and documented. A new program for clients was created to help individuals set and achieve their goals. All of these things would not be possible without every person's sacrifice.

My hope for 2017 is that PSIC can continue to grow. We would like to expand our client base to reach those that we have not been able to reach in the past. We want to add even more classes to our Earn While You Learn program including Spanish and Life Skills Curriculum. Another dream is to open our doors for more than 2 days per week and offer group classes so we will be able to see more clients. Our ultimate dream is to open as a medical facility offering free ultrasounds and pregnancy testing. Unfortunately, all of these goals are expensive. *For the past two years, PSIC has been able to operate on less than \$35,000 per year. We have been able to accomplish so much with so little. Just imagine who we could help and the lives we could change if we had just a 50% increase in income!*

If you can't help financially consider this: even if everything mentioned above was free, we would still need your help. In 2016, our volunteers donated over 1,000 hours of their time. We are currently most in need of Client Advocates and Receptionists to welcome our clients into our center. I have not even touched on our greatest need—prayer. *The Lord is the reason that PSIC exists. Without God there is absolutely no way that we would ever be able to reach our clients and help to change their lives.* Prayer is something we need from you every day especially while we are open. Thank you for your continued support and generosity as it is truly appreciated by every person involved in PSIC.



Diaper Need



One diaper (newborn size) costs about 30 cents and infants use about 240 diapers (\$72) a month. It's estimated that 1 in 3 moms in the U.S. lack a sufficient supply of diapers to keep their baby clean, dry, and healthy. Our Earn While You Learn program enables clients to earn up to 25 diapers each time they attend a parenting class. Thus far in 2016, clients earned over 7,800 diapers! The Mid-Michigan Diaper Bank is no longer in operation. Are you able to donate toward our diaper fund to help us meet this need for our clients?


