## A Word from the Director

*Did you know that statistics say 65-70% of women who have abortions call themselves Christians and 45% are active in their church?*

It has been two years since the Board asked me to fill the position of Executive Director. Many things have happened since that Spring of 2014. That first summer, we were closed except for one day a month for material assistance and as needed for pregnancy tests. This was temporary so we all could be trained to better serve clients faced with an unexpected pregnancy. In 2015, we introduced the *Earn While You Learn* program and changed our name to **PSIC** which stands for **Positive Solutions • Informed Choices**. Our most recent change was a complete makeover of the center, entirely paid for and completed by the volunteers.

What are PSIC's future goals? We have two major goals we hope to accomplish.

**PSIC's first goal is to reach those who may be considering abortion. We want to help them find positive solutions through informed choices.** There were forty-eight induced abortions recorded for Ionia County in 2014 (the last year statistics are available). PSIC hopes to reach and empower those facing this decision to choose life before they turn to an abortion clinic. If PSIC could offer ultrasounds, we would be helping clients make a better informed choice. Referring to other pregnancy help centers isn't feasible because many considering abortion have limited transportation. PSIC currently has two RNs volunteering, but we need finances for medical equipment and other costs associated with becoming a licensed medical clinic. We also need a Christian pro-life doctor on board to oversee and guide the medical aspects of the center.

**PSIC's second goal is to offer post-abortion healing classes.** Did you know that statistics say 65-70% of women who have had an abortion consider themselves Christians and 45% are active in their church? If 4 in 10 women have had at least one abortion, that is a lot of women sitting in our churches, suffering in silence. When asked why they keep the abortion a secret and don't reach out for help, most say it is because of fear of judgment and condemnation, guilt, shame and grief. They hear anti-abortion sermons, but never once have heard a sermon on God's forgiveness for abortion. As a pastor's wife and women's Bible study leader, this really spoke to me. Plus, for every woman that has chosen abortion there may be a man also suffering.

*Isn't it time we reach out to them?* PSIC would like to offer help and hope. We are a place where they can feel safe and non-judged. We also want to help equip churches to reach these men and women in their congregations. *"Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."* Ephesians 4:31-32 (NIV)

Thank you for your support these past two years. I'm looking forward to seeing where God guides PSIC in the next two years.

Lastly, if you, or someone you love, is struggling after abortion, we are here to help!
