USER INSTRUCTIONS (May 2018)

Care and Use of your Septic Tank Effluent Pumping, STEP, System

The sewer system is capable of accepting and pumping a wide range of materials. ALSSD advises the following items should NOT be introduced into any sewers via drains, toilets, kitchen waste disposals, showers, dishwashers, etc. If any non-acceptable items are discovered and/or cause a pump failure, the homeowner may be liable for any and all costs associated with the repair.

Power Failure

The sewer system **cannot** dispose of wastewater without electrical power. If electrical service is interrupted, keep water/wastewater usage to a minimum. DO NOT introduce portable power and continue usage as the treatment plant may also be disabled and unable to handle the added flows.

Pump Alarm

The sewer system has an alarm located in the control panel. If a problem is detected a red light on top of the control panel will blink and/or an audible alarm will sound.

If the light and/or audible alarm comes on:

- 1. DO NOT turn the pump electrical supply off.
- DO NOT attempt to repair yourself.
- Silence the audible alarm by pressing a button/switch on the side of the control box.
