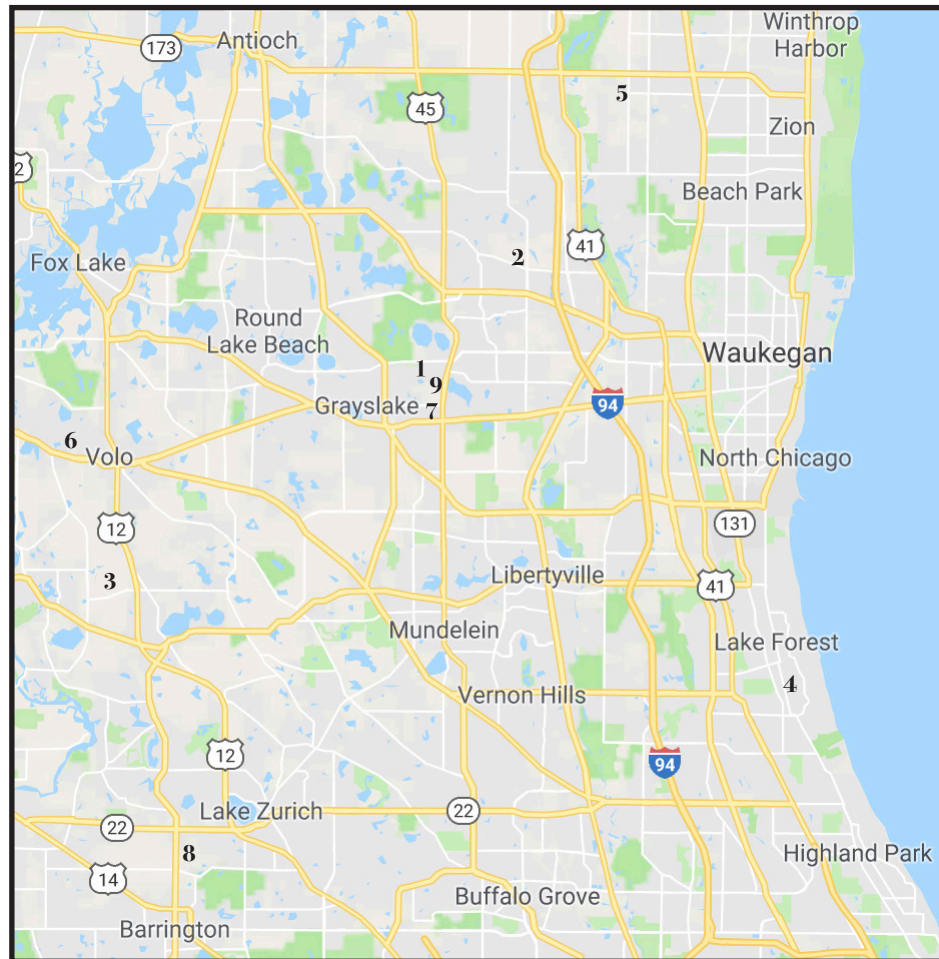


Farm Stroll Participants Map
