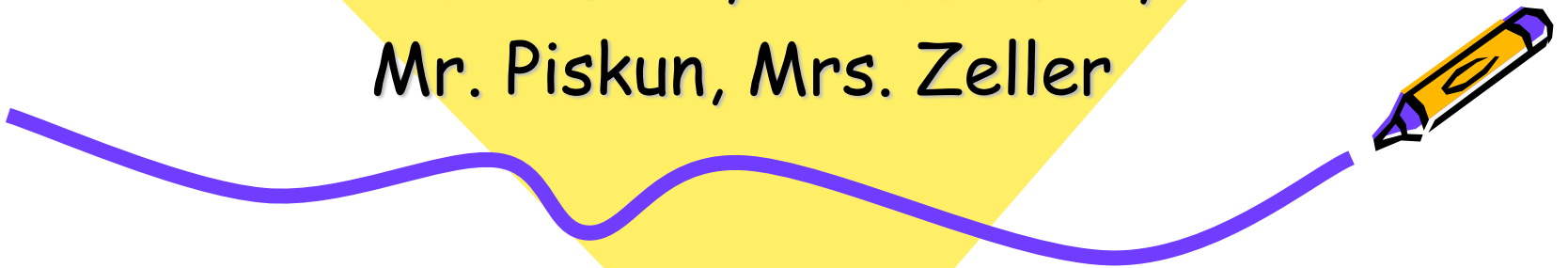

Expectations

Grades are updated at least once a week.



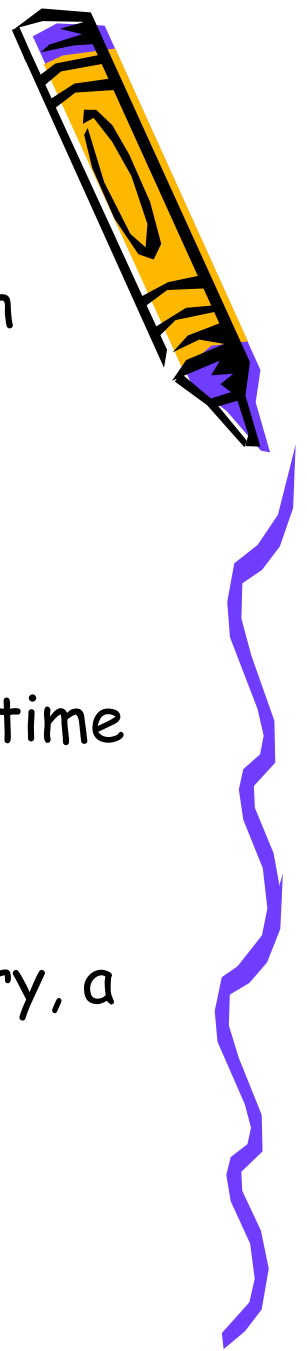
BROWARD COUNTY CELL PHONE POLICY

- This is a Broward County Code of Conduct rule and will be enforced!



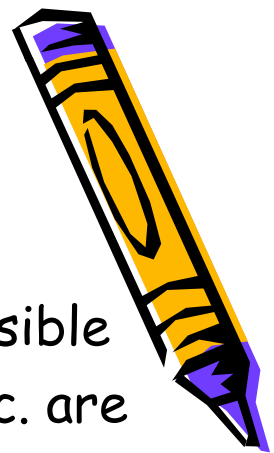
Resolution of Conflict



- Step One: Student should have a dialogue with the teacher.
- Step Two: If clarification is needed, parents should email or call the teacher. Please be advised, teachers will respond within a 24 hr. time frame NOT including Saturdays and Sundays.
- Step Three: If further discussion is necessary, a parent conference will be scheduled with the ENTIRE TEAM.



6th Grade Etiquette



- All assignments, classwork **MUST** have proper headings
- No LIQUID paper is allowed; correction tape is permissible
- No fidget spinners or cubes, slime, goo, **ANY TOYS**, etc. are allowed.
- 6th grade students should be armed with a novel and reading in the hallway before classes start in the mornings.
- Whenever students are in the hallway they **MUST** be quiet (we share the hallways with other grade levels that have different schedules)
- In the lunchroom, students **MUST**: clean up after themselves, **NOT** take other people's food, use food as a projectile, and maintain a reasonable voice level.
- We are all **PARTNERS** in education.



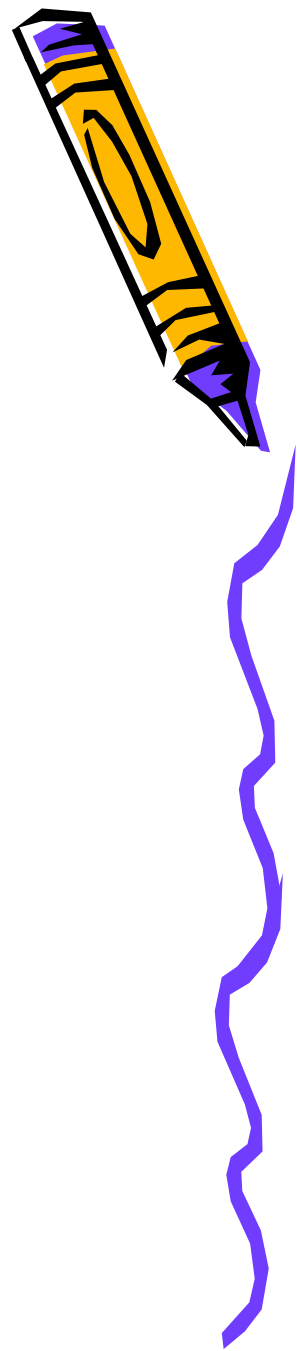
Discipline
