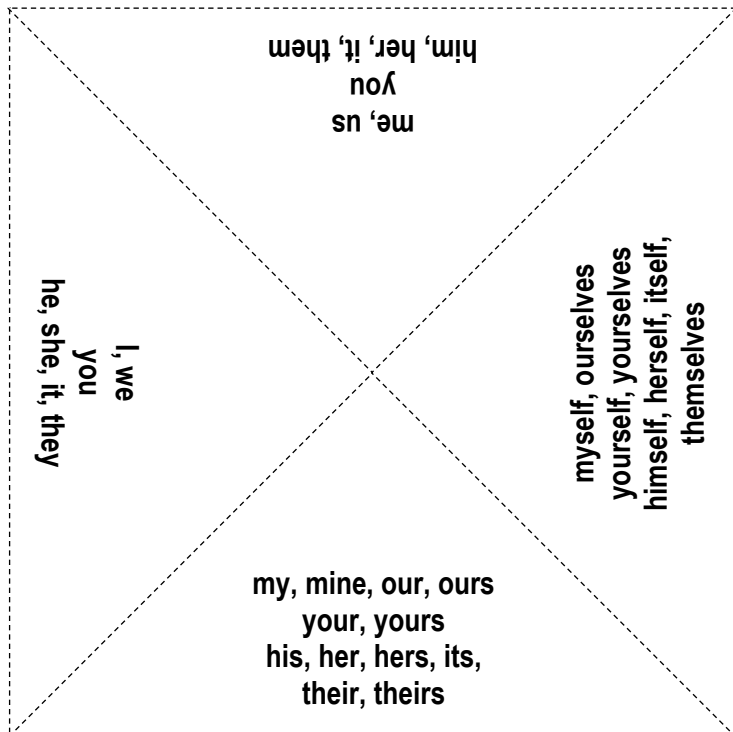
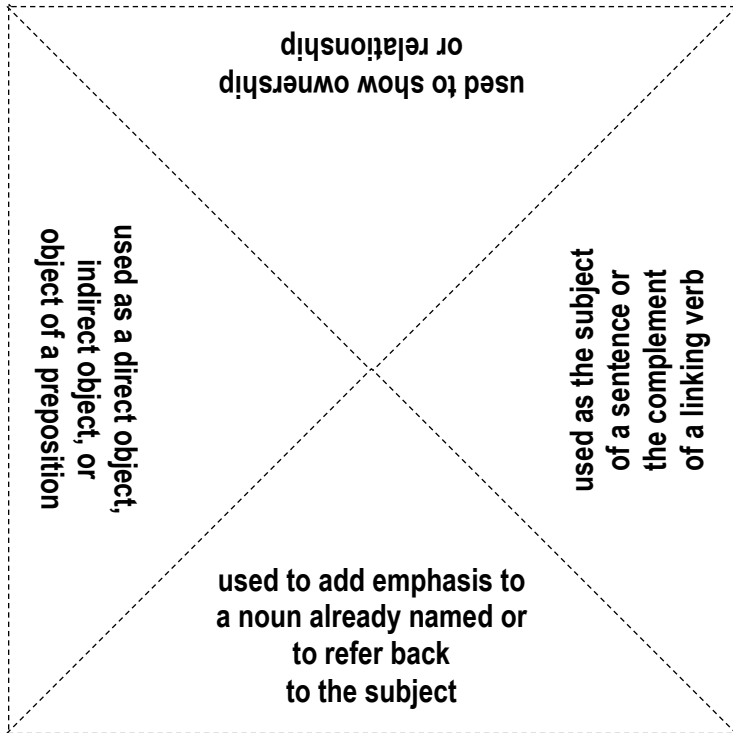


Pronoun Fortune Teller

4. Enjoy!



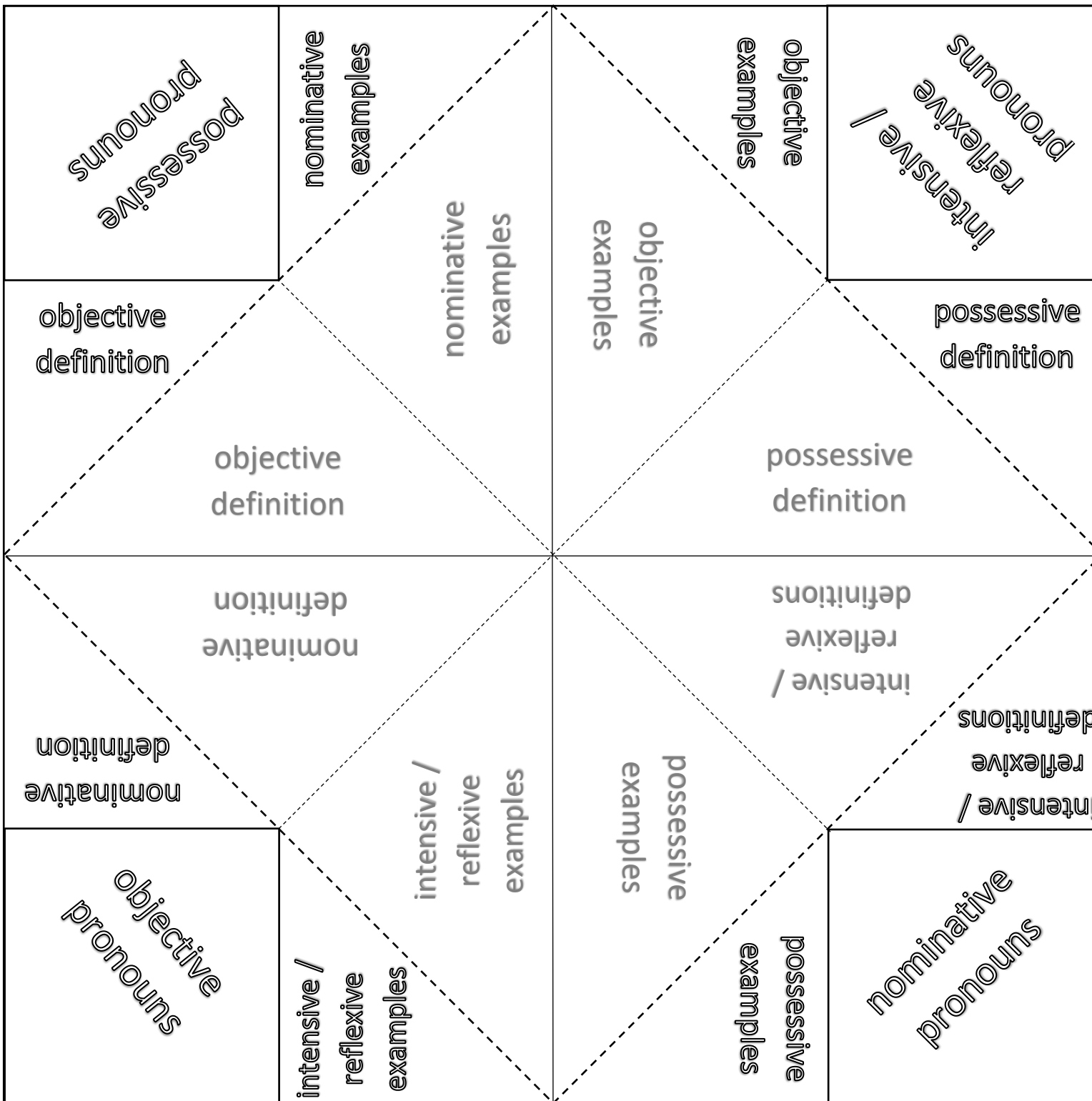
Pronoun Fun Facts

Personal pronouns include nominative, objective, and possessive.

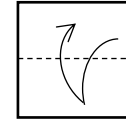
In compound subjects or objects, etiquette demands that pronouns come last.



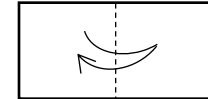
Pronoun Fortune Teller

Instructions:

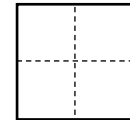
1. Cut along the edges of the outer square.
2. Fold along the horizontal line, text facing out.



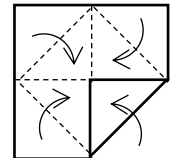
3. Fold along the vertical line, text facing out.



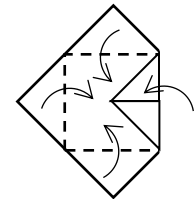
4. Open the entire square and flip it text down on the desk.



5. Fold each corner to the center.



6. Flip the square over and fold each corner to the center.



7. Fold in half and place your fingers under the flaps.
