



Instructions:

1. Color each number a different color. Cut out the triangle, pyramid net, title box, and all 7 power class boxes.
2. *Fold down (away from print) along all lines indicated in the pyramid, lines between triangles, and the line between the right-most triangle and the striped tab below it..*
3. Fold up (towards print) the dotted line in the center of the middle triangle. Open all folds.
4. *Glue the striped tab to the outside of the shaded area on the opposite triangle, creating a 3-sided pyramid.*
5. Push the side with the center fold inward to flatten the pyramid.
6. *Fold up the isosceles triangle on the dotted line. Apply glue to the pyramid's triangular tab marked "A" and position the side indicated along the fold of the card, as centered along the dotted line as possible. The tab marked "B" should be facing up.*
7. Apply glue to the tab marked "B" and fold the isosceles triangle onto the glued tab. When you open the triangle, your pyramid should pop up.
8. *Glue half of the base of the isosceles triangle to the top of the page in your interactive notebook so that the pyramid does not poke out of the side of the sheet.*
9. Below the pyramid structure, glue the social class boxes in order from most to least powerful and number them accordingly. Color the power class boxes to match the appropriate stripes. Give a brief description of each "job."
