

<b>Noun/ Pronoun Functions in a Sentence</b>	subject	Who or what the sentence is about (who is doing/being)
	predicate nominative	Renames the subject following a linking verb
	direct object	Who or what receives the action (action verb)
	indirect object	Comes between an action verb and direct object (replaces "to/for what/whom")
	object of preposition	Final word in prepositional phrase
	appositive	Immediately follows another noun and renames/gives additional information
