An indefinite pronoun refers to a non-specific person, place, or thing. As with all pronouns, an indefinite pronoun substitutes for a noun. Some are always singular, some are always plural, and some depend on their context.

*Always Singular*

Instructions: Cut out the title ("Indefinite Pronouns" and the four large rectangles labelled "Indefinite Pronouns," "Always Plural," "Always Singular," and "Singular or Plural..."
