

The Lee's Summit North Theatre Boosters' scholarships are awarded to seniors who plan to pursue additional education upon graduation. Award amounts vary.

Eligibility: To be considered, the student must have the following:

- 1) Completed the requirements to become a member of the International Thespian Society at Lee's Summit North High School.
- 2) Actively participated in theatre productions, either on-stage or backstage, through high school career.
- 3) Maintained the standing of being a "credible citizen" throughout the four years of high school (no more than one infraction of the code of conduct).

Review Process: A committee of Lee's Summit North Theatre Boosters will review the applications and conduct interviews with each applicant. Recipients are selected based on total scores from both the application and the interview process. Scholarship awards will be presented at the theatre banquet on Thursday, April 26, 2018.

Criteria to be Considered:

- Citizenship
- Participation in LSN productions
- Participation in LSN drama club and theatre classes
- ITS points
- Application interview

Application deadline to submit paperwork and to schedule an interview is Tuesday, April 3, 2018 at 2:30 p.m.

The paperwork must be handed-in to Mr. Daniel and an interview appointment will be scheduled using the Signup Genius on the Google Classroom Drama Department.

Interviews will be held on Wednesday, April 4, 2018. Each interview will be approximately 15-20 minutes in duration.

Part IV - Citizenship

To be eligible for a Theatre Boosters scholarship, applicants must have maintained the status of "credible citizen" throughout the four years of high school (no more than one infraction of the code of conduct allowed).

- 2. Students who do not attend parties where minors possess or use alcohol and/or possess or use non-prescription drugs.
- 3. Students who are in good standing with the judicial and/or legal system.
- 4. Students who are not under school suspension as a result of disciplinary consequences.
- 5. Students who choose not to be present where illegal activities are occurring.
