BRONSON—The Coldwater Area Chamber of Commerce and Sturgis Chamber of Commerce came together Tuesday to host an “After Business Hours” event and the newly renovated Ancestral Acres Lodge, located at 1063 Holmes Road, in Bronson.

Owner and lodge manager William Berkman took five years to complete the renovations on the home, which sits on 450 acres of a nature preserve. The residence contains six spacious bedrooms, many with their own fireplaces, and five bathrooms.

The third floor was completely redone and boasts ballroom seating for 75 guests.

Berkman’s family purchased the home in 1968-69. At the time, it had no windows, no furnace and was all boarded up.

“When I was younger, we had a pig, not one that ran around and ate feed, but one that was turquoise, and had the words ‘Ancestral Acres’ written on it, my father said, ‘we keep putting money in this piggy bank and someday we can buy a house and fix it up.’ This house was my father’s dream,” Berkman said.

He continued to recall memories of his past, as he spoke in front of a large group of Chamber members.

The Ancestral Acres Lodge is now open for lodge and room rentals, weddings, retreats, private dinners and even has an outdoor event space.
