Cohort information:

3 girls (25%), 9 boys (75%); SEN 6 (50%); Pupil premium 6 children (50%)

1 child was unable to access tests which obviously impacts upon percentages

4 children only started with us less than a year before the tests so we were unable to have a great impact upon their achievement.

If the late joiners are taken out, we exceed national percentages in reading and our scaled score matches National; percentages are in line with National for maths and our average scaled score is 100; and percentages are only just below in writing and GPS, with an average scaled score in GPS of 101.

Strengths:

- The longer the children are with us the better they do
- All children who scored 2b at KS1 went on to achieve expected levels in KS2 in all subjects.
- EAL scaled scores were above average
- Pupil premium children were above average in writing
