<p>2 Encourage greater take-up of sport-lessons, after school clubs, external providers so that 75% of children regularly access after school clubs/activities and all children have taken part in at least one activity.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to subsidise clubs.</li> <li>• Open up all clubs to all children (if not over subscribed)</li> <li>• Consider age related clubs.</li> <li>• Offer of taster sessions to encourage club take up</li> <li>• Continue to source inspirational coaches that will meet the needs of the differing interests.</li> <li>• Identify funded coaches such as the 'Chance to shine' cricket programme and Badminton with Janis Baker.</li> <li>• Identify local clubs. Ask if coaches will come in and offer sample session or demo.
