

Sports Action Plan-St Mary Federation 2017-2018

The PE & Sport Premium has been provided in order to improve the provision of Physical Education & Sport in Primary Schools.

Schools receive a lump sum of £16,000 plus £10 per eligible pupil in Yr1-Yr6. 7/12's of each years allocation is received in October and 5/12's in April.

Last year: Brancaster received £8150.00, Docking £8604.00 & Sedgeford £8139.00

This funding is ring-fenced and can only be spent on provision for PE and Sport in School.

This year the Federation has moved to a single budget and should receive £49,670

St Mary Federation encourage collaboration and partnership working to make the best use of resources and enhance PE and Sport provision in order to raise participation and achievement for all pupils.

We have created a Sports Premium Action plan to raise standards and participation levels in PE throughout the 3 schools.

Our rationale for the use of Sports Premium Funding are, that it must be used so that:

- All children benefit regardless of ability.
- Staff will have access to training opportunities and continued professional development.
- The most able children are given the opportunity to compete in cluster and additional school tournaments.
- We make use of collaborative and partnership working including within the Federation.
- Any spending/investment must have a legacy and/ or be sustainable.

The impact of Sports Premium funding is reported to the school governing body.
