Library Scheme

The Library Scheme was introduced to encourage more pupils to come and find out for themselves the enjoyment that can be had from looking and reading books on a vast selection of topics.

Every time a child attends a library session, they will receive a sticker on a chart. After 4 stickers, they will receive a special 'bookworm' certificate. After 8 sessions they will receive a 'star reader' certificate and a free book to enjoy at home. This will continue on a similar basis as often as necessary – so after receiving their free book, they will receive another certificate after another 4 sessions, and another book after that – and so on.

The library is open on Tuesday mornings between 8.30 and 8.55am and during the morning breaktime.
