Volunteer to teach school programs!

1st grade (in school) “Discovering My Neighborhood” reveals the history of Andover’s school neighborhoods and students examine real 100 year old objects. (November through January)

3rd grade (at the History Center) “Andover at Work in the 1820s” explores life in the 1820s through the eyes of people living at the time and through rotations at hands-on stations set up at our historic 1819 house (May)

4th grade (along the Merrimack River) “Native Peoples of the Merrimack Valley” is a hands on history and archaeology program conducted on land next to the Merrimack River. Students examine a replica dig site and handle real Native American artifacts. (October)
