Section 1. *Regular Members,*

- Persons who have passed Guards/HC training to become posted as a regular soldier to one of the seven regiments that form the Household Division. Currently serving or has now left.
- Persons not serving within the Household Division but receiving disability income or job re-assignment due to injuries while in serving in the Household Division, or who are receiving retirement income for full-time employment after leaving the Household Division.
- Persons may apply for regular after 1 year without discrepancy as an associate member.

Section 2. *Associate Members,*

- Persons attached to one of the 7 regiments that form the Household Division.
- Persons who are part time in an attached Reserve Unit.
- A close family member to a Regular member

***All Regular and Associate members must be licensed to drive a motorcycle by the town or city, in which they reside and must own a motorcycle. Persons who qualify but do not own a motorcycle can become members if they acquire ownership within 6 months of becoming a member.

section 3. *Honorary members.*

- Persons who substantially contribute to promoting the household Division MCC, to the purposes for which the HDMCC is organised. Honorary membership in any given chapter may not exceed more than ten 10% of the previous year's membership of Regular, Associate and Life members.

section 4. *Special Honorary member.*

- persons from an outside organisation offering a service for the benefit of HDMCC members. Or an ordained member of a recognised religious order. There can be only one Chaplain per chapter.
