# BRIGHTON SPEED TRIALS 1956



This Event is the 51st Anniversary of Brighton Speed Trials and the entry is again a record, 256 cars against 230 cars entered last year. What an amazing selection of vehicles to observe, ranging from 250 c.c. to 27000 c.c. Ken Wharton E.R.A. is present to defend his Car Course Record of 23.63 secs. This time has only been improved by R. Charlton (998 c.c. Vincent) the Motorcycle Course Record holder who last year became the first man to exceed an average speed of 100 m.p.h. at Brighton Speed Trials with a time of 22.27 secs. The Swandean Spitfire Special driven by F. M. Wilcock has had considerable modifications since competing 2 years ago and we hope that the 27000 c.c. aero-engine car, built specially for this event, will show its paces today.

Class Records broken in 1955 event : R. Watling Greenwood improved his record on an R.W.G. for Sports Cars up to 1100 c.c. from 34.89 to 29.65 secs. with a Cooper. Sports Cars 1101 to 1500 c.c. Lt. Col. White, Lotus M.G., 30.19 secs. breaking H. Lester's M.G. record of 31.89 secs. Sports Cars over 2501 c.c. Cyril Wick, Cooper-Jaguar, 25.30 secs. breaking Sidney Allard's record of 27.40 secs. Supercharged Sports Cars up to 2000 c.c. A. K. Haworth, Bugatti 30.67 secs. breaking V. J. Hern's long standing record of 30.80 secs. Although there was a record entry of 18 in the Ladies Class, the 1948 record by Mrs. F. R. Gerard, E.R.A., 25.80 secs. remained unbroken.

Looking through a Results Sheet for 1948 it is interesting to compare today's record entry with that entry of 120 cars. Many well known names were included—Reg Parnell, Masarati, won the Racing Car Class up to 1500 c.c. in 28.32 secs. S. Allard and R. C. C. Walker both competing today were also at this meeting. Mike Hawthorn and Stirling Moss started their racing careers at Brighton Speed Trials.

Brightonians competing in the Racing Classes include T. H. Shaddick, Shaddick Viper 500 c.c., I. E. Raby, whose Cooper 500 c.c. was class winner last year, Mike Anthony whose Lotus-Bristol has the engine mounted on its side thereby decreasing frontal area.

The organisers have endeavoured to pair Sports Car Competitors to give interesting comparisons with cars of equal performance, but in the higher capacity Racing Car Classes this has not been attempted in the interests of safety.
