Some of the Drivers . .

This event is the 52nd Anniversary of Brighton Speed Trials and the entry is again a record : 268 cars and 80 motorcycles.

We shall all miss Ken Wharton who met with a fatal accident whilst racing abroad. He captured Raymond May's long standing record for the Best Time of the Day for Cars and last year broke his own record with a run of 23.34 secs. This time has only been beaten by R. Charlton (998 c.c Vincent) the Motorcycle Course Record Holder who in 1955 became the first man to exceed an average speed 100 m.p.h. for the course with a time of 22.27 secs.

The E.R.A. used by Ken Wharton is competing today driven by T. Driver. Also competing is a car which has made Best Time of the Day at this event. F. M. Wilcock is driving the ex-Lloyd Jones aero-engined car now known as the Flying Saucer. W. C. Jackson is driving the Aston Butterworth powered by an air-cooled engine which should also be in the running for the Premier Award.

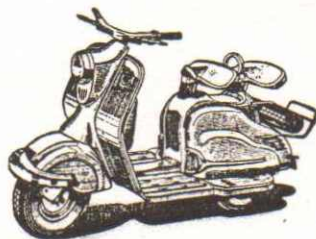

Series Production Sports Cars . . .

One of the most interesting parts of the motor sport scene today is certainly the 'Series Production' Class which not only serves as a yardstick for us all to judge the speeds of the racing cars, but allows us the thrill of recognising cars identical to those we own or could hope to own in the foreseeable future.

To qualify for the title 'Series Production' the organisers attempt to provide a set of qualifications which in everyday language mean that the car is produced in the normal way of business for road users who are enabled to drive on the public highway without undue discomfort to themselves or their passengers and without inconveniencing other road users. Samples of most of the vehicles you will see here performing under this heading can be seen on the open roads performing the ordinary duties of a dual purpose sports car, they were made originally with normal watertight hoods, sidescreens, heaters, etc., but are used in the season for competitive sport as well.

The Ace Bristol two litre, undoubtedly one of the most potent road cars of the day, is made in small quantities to the ideas of a racing chassis designer and built by one of the oldest firms in the business who have been famous for over 50 years for their quality cars. Its docility in traffic, its relative silence even when driven fast and its fascinating ability to cover the ground on the crowded roads of England at very high average speeds, wet or dry, have endeared it in the hearts of hard driving motorists of all ages.

The example driven here by K. N. Rudd has covered more than 50,000 miles in the last three years and completed over 50 race, sprint and hill climb meetings throughout the country and will be remembered as the car in which Ken scored an overwhelming number of points in the Autosport Production Sports Car Championship last year. It is interesting to note that his racing friend Bob Jennings has partnered him this season in keeping the Ace at the top of the Championship and the car is maintained by K. N. Rudd (Engnrs.) Ltd., 41 High St., Worthing, who are interested in supplying and maintaining high grade sports cars of all types.
