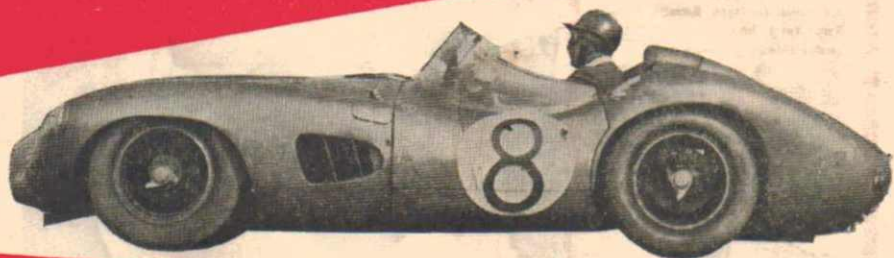

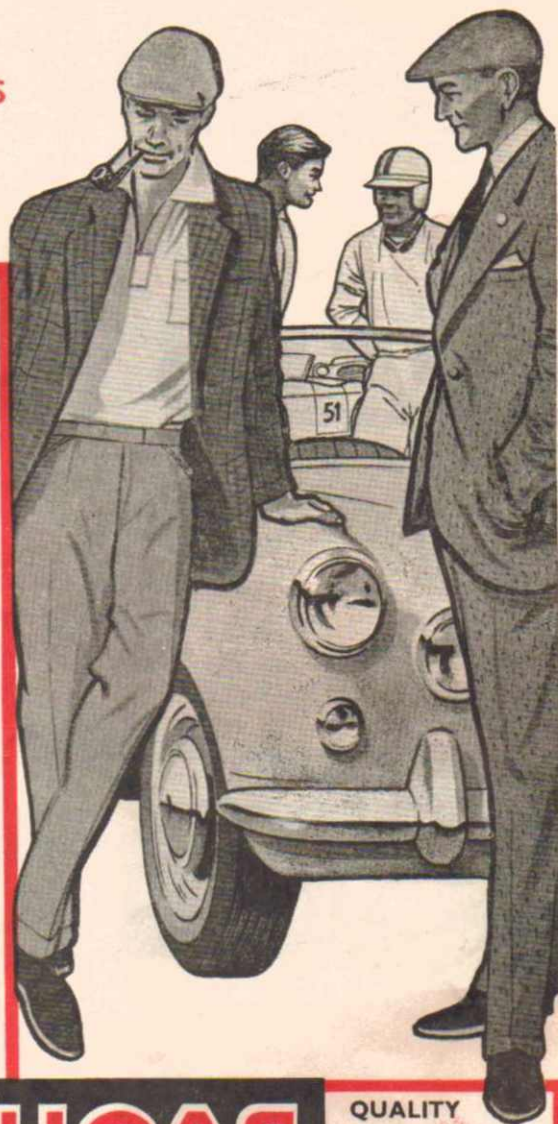

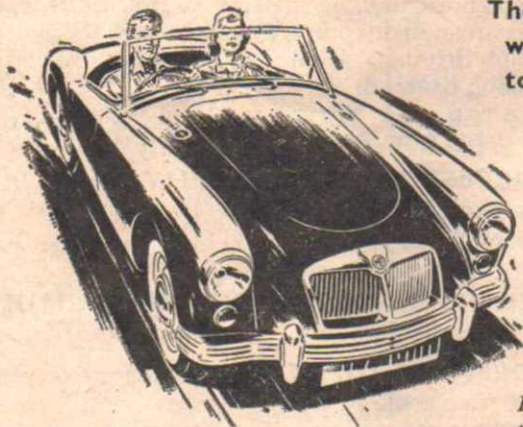

Brighton Speed Trials, 1961.

The 56th anniversary of Brighton Speed Trials with an entry of 240.

Last year the long standing Car Course Record of Ken Wharton was taken by J. Berry (1960 c.c. E.R.A. Spec. s.) with his time of 23.21 secs. for the Standing Start Kilometre. He is competing this year also Arthur Owen from St. Helier, Jersey, who made fastest time of the day in 1959 and 1960 with his 2500 c.c. Cooper s. Sydney Allard, who is well known at this event, is entering his Allard Dragster with 5.7 litre Chrysler V-8 s. engine. The driver sits behind the rear axle which is un-sprung. Only two speeds are used (Top gear 3 to 1, bottom gear 4 to 1) and a parachute is fitted which may be used to assist braking at the Finish. There will be great competition between these three competitors for fastest time of the day in 1961.

Two interesting cars entered in Class 15 are the 1912 21,800 c.c. Benz driven by Stanley Sears who is also driving a Bentley, and the 1907 F.I.A.T. "Mephistopheles" originally driven by Nazarro. In 1922 the present 21,714 c.c. engine was fitted by E. A. D. Eldridge and held the World's Land Speed Record in 1924. It will be driven today by J. P. H. Gresham, and this year has made its first appearance since before the war. In Class 12, Gordon March has again entered "Djinn" 1098 c.c. s. which, driven by C. R. Instone, holds the Class Record for Racing Cars 501 to 1100 c.c. and 1101 to 1500 c.c. The Sports Car Record Holder since 1959, M. P. Anthony (Lister 5555 c.c.) is defending his title in Class 6.

The Motorcycle Course Record Holder, C. W. Rous, (Moto-Vincent 21.67 secs.) will not be running today but George Brown, who recently took the World's Standing Start Kilometre Record from Italy with an average speed of 108.74 m.p.h. is competing with a Vincent Special.

Due to the wet course during the morning in 1960, no Sports Car Records were broken, but with a dry track in the afternoon, the following Records were made in the Racing Classes.
