IMPLANT SURGERY

Patients are required to remain in town for 10 days following implant surgery. If the surgery is for placement of implants in the maxillary (upper) arch, patients are not to fly for 3 weeks following the surgery.

DENTURE/PARTIAL DENTURE IMPRESSIONS

Patients for dental and partial denture impressions are to leave out their existing appliances beginning the night before their appointment.

NIGHT GUARD ADJUSTMENTS

Patients scheduled for adjustments to their night guard are to wear their appliance the night before and up until their appointment, removing it only for eating and brushing of their teeth.

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ANTIBIOTIC PREMEDICATION

Patients who, for certain medical conditions, are required to take antibiotics prior to invasive dental procedures must remember to do so 1 hour before their appointment. A charge will be made for procedures that are not able to be completed because a patient has not premedicated.

PERIOGUARD

In selected instances, patients will be instructed in the use of PERIOGUARD. Following surgical procedures, and prior to tooth preparations and/or cementation of final restorations.
