Applause for both teams.

A lot has been said in the news of late regarding respect and child safety, we will have a regular feature highlighting what we as a club do and what we expect from everyone involved with the club, players, coaches, referees, volunteers and supporters. Tamworth Junior Football League rules state as a Charter Standard Club, ONLY Club Officials, Managers, Coaches and First Aid Officials that have undergone a Club Criminal Record Check and completed the FA Safeguarding Course are permitted to assist in any capacity with the teams involved in any TJFL Competition on match days.

The Respect Barrier / designated spectator/supporter area

All Clubs must ensure that they have a designated supporter's area. The area should normally be at least 2m from the touchline and run the entire length of the pitch. Where possible ALL supporters should stand on the opposite side to players and club officials. Wherever possible ALL supporters will stand in the designated spectator area.



The technical area is for players, substitutes and designated match day officials only.
