



Emergency Action Plan (EAP)

In case of emergency...

----- (Team Manager) will contact Emergency Medical Services (EMS).

----- (Team Assistant and/or designated adult) will wait at the entrance to Measham Medical Unit/Measham Leisure Centre to direct the EMS team (s).

Another Club Official – if present – (and/or the Match Referee and/or designated adult:

-----) will be responsible for the assembly of all attending players at the following location: *by footbridge opposite the All-Weather Pitch* (AWP).

I, the Team Manager, will ensure...

- That there is an unimpeded route for the EMS vehicle from the Measham Leisure Centre car park to the playing fields. (if required - Bollard keys available at reception)
- That all necessary player medications (such as Inhalers) are to hand.
- That the manager of the opposition is either: (a) given a copy of this EAP, or, (b) instructed to contact the home Team Manager in the event of any emergencies.
- That the Match Referee is either: (a) given a copy of this EAP, or, (b) instructed to contact the home Team Manager in the event of any emergencies.
