

NRA Open Conventional Pistol Sectional
Hosted by the Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club
March 16-17, 2018

Location: The Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club's 12 point indoor range is located at 7650 North Western St. If you are going west on I-40 turn right on Western St., if you are going east on I-40 turn left on Western St. go 7 miles north. The range is located on the east side of the road.

Time: Friday, and Saturday, March 16-17, 2018. There will be one relay Friday evening starting at 6:00. Saturday's relays start at 9:00 AM; each subsequent relay approximately 13/4 hours later until completion.

Entries: Limited to 48 competitors. Post entries accepted to range capacity, provided extra relays are not required. All competitors must check with the Statistical Officer prior to firing to draw targets and complete the NRA Sectional Score Card.

Squading: All matches will be squadded.

Eligibility: NRA membership is not required, but competitors must be NRA members to compete for NRA National Records and Awards. **NOTE: A competitor may compete for score in only one NRA Conventional Pistol Sectional per year or risk disqualification.**

Fees: Entry fee accepted at match entry. Please call or e-mail for special relay times.

Package entry: Individual matches # 1-5: \$25.00
Team Match #6: \$24.00 (\$6 each), four person teams.

Match Schedule: All firing will be at 50' with a 22 caliber pistol

- Match 1 – Individual 20 shot slow fire.
- Match 2 – Individual 30 shot gallery course (NMC)
- Match 3 – Individual 20 shot timed fire
- Match 4 – Individual 20 shot rapid fire
- Match 5 – National Indoor Sectional Championship
- Match 6 – National Sectional Team Championship (30 shot gallery NMC for all 4 team members)

Team Entries: Must be made by the Team Captain to the Statistical Office prior to firing the Team Match to draw targets.

Team matches will be fired after the last relay.

Classification: NRA classification will be used. Unclassified competitors will fire in the High Master class unless there are enough (3 or more) to form a class

Firing Procedure: Scoring will be after 10 shots by the competitor, with all fired targets turned in to the Range Officer after firing. The complete 900 point individual gallery aggregate will be completed before relays are changed or the Team Match started.

Awards: NRA will furnish awards.

Overall: 1st place – 15 points, 2nd place (at least 15 competitors) – 10 points, 3rd place (at least 30 competitors) -5 points.

Class and category awards: 1st place (5 in class) – 10 points, 2nd place (8 in class) – 8 points, 3rd place (13 in class) – 6 points.

High Team (at least 2 teams, for winning team only) – 20 points (5 per member).

Score Cards: A special NRA Sectional Registration and Score Card will be used and must be completed and signed by the competitor and turned in to the Statistical Office to be eligible for national ranking and awards

Accommodations: All of the major motel/hotel chains are represented on I-40 within a few minutes of the range. There is limited RV parking at the range with electricity available.

1800 Conventional Pistol Match: The Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club will hold an 1800 match Sunday March 18, 2018 starting at 9:00 AM. The 1800 will be fired in relays. Entry fee will be \$20.00. The first relay will be filled before the second will be formed. Advanced entry is requested. Limited to 24 competitors.
