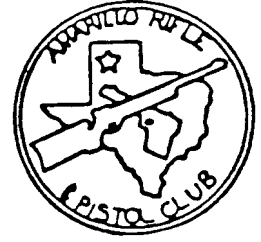

## TOP OF TEXAS CONVENTIONAL PRONE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

**JULY 21-22, 2018**

**LOCATION:** Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club, 7650 N. Western, Amarillo, TX. Take the Western Street exit (#67) off I-40 and go north on Western Street. The range is located 2.2 miles North of Loop 335. See the attached map.

**ELIGIBILITY: THIS IS AN NRA REGISTERED TOURNAMENT. OPEN TO ALL COMPETITORS. MEMBERSHIP IN THE NRA IS NOT REQUIRED.**

**SCOPE SHOOTERS:** ANYONE may elect to shoot Any Sights (SCOPE) both days. Such shooters will be in a separate Class for Saturday's matches, but will be with their regular Classification on Sunday's matches. They will not be eligible for Grand Aggregate awards, but will be eligible for all other awards.

**F-CLASS SHOOTER:** There is an F-Class division. Current NRA F-class rules will apply in regards to equipment. There will be no classes, categories or division of rifle. F-Class shooters will use NRA metric targets (A-51, reduced for 50 yards) and A-33 (100 yards).

**ENTRIES:**

Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made by using the enclosed registration entry card accompanied by check or money order. Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA classification and NRA member number. **Mail entry card immediately to the above address:**

**Entries limited: Entries are limited to 36 competitors.**

**FEES:**

**\$50.00 for both days or \$30.00 for one day will include all individual matches, aggregates and NRA registration fees.**

**Juniors may enter for \$30.00 for two days or \$20.00 for one day but will not compete for open awards.**

**FIRING TIME:** COMMENCE FIRING will be at 8:30 AM CDT SHARP!

**SOUVENIR PINS:** Will be given to each individual who competes.

**RIFLE:** Rule 3.2

**TARGET:** NRA Official Targets will be used.

**CHALLENGES:** A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. See NRA Rule 16 for procedure.

**CLASSIFICATION:** The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 – Assigned Classification, or 19.2 – Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament.

**AWARDS:** To the Winner, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall medallions (provided entries warrant) and the winning team awards in the team matches are furnished by the NRA. Approximately 65% of match entry fees will be returned as awards in cash, NRA award points or trophies. Juniors will receive trophies. Juniors will be eligible to win all awards, but these awards will be of approx. ½ the value of Open awards.

### **AWARDS FURNISHED BY THE TOURNAMENT SPONSOR**

**CLASS & CATEGORY:** Class and category will be determined by the number of entries in each. Classes and categories that have enough entries to stand alone, will. Class/categories with insufficient entries will be combined for awards. Awards will be issued as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place for 3 entries, 2<sup>nd</sup> place for 5 entries, 3<sup>rd</sup> place for 7 entries

### **REGIONAL AWARDS SCHEDULE**

(Furnished by the NRA)

#### **GRAND AGGREGATE**

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion (with a minimum of 8 competitors)  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion (with a minimum of 10 shooters)  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion (with a minimum of 15 shooters)

#### **AWARDS FOR FIRED TEAM MATCHES – METALLIC SIGHT AND ANY SIGHT**

A medal will be awarded each member of the two-member adult/junior team or 5 Award Points for each team member of the winning team.

#### **CATEGORY AND CLASS AWARDS** (GRAND AGGREGATE)

For each class in each category

1<sup>st</sup> Place – minimum of 3 shooters in category/class  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place – with 5 or more shooters in category/class  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place – with 7 or more shooters in category/class

Winner: Metallic Sight Aggregate  
Any Sight Aggregate

**CATEGORY & CLASS AWARDS:** In the metallic sight aggregate or any sight aggregate. For each class in each category:

1<sup>st</sup> Place – minimum of 3 shooters in category/class  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place – with 5 or more shooters in category/class  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place – with 7 or more shooters in category/class

#### **AWARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL FIRED MATCHES**

Furnished by Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club

The number of competitors in a class in a category will determine the amount of awards as above. Three competitors establish a class in a category, 5 competitors 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 7 competitors 3<sup>rd</sup>, etc. Awards will be cash, NRA award point or trophies. Juniors will receive trophies.

Match No. 3 40 shots, 50 Meters reduced for 50 Yards Metallic Sights – A-27 Target  
Match No. 4 40 shots, 50 Yards Metallic Sights – A-23 Target

Match No. 5 Regional Metallic Sight Championship  
Total of Matches 1, 2, 3, 4

Commencing at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday, May 21<sup>st</sup>

Match No. 7 40 shots, 100 Yards Any Sights –A-25 Target  
Match No. 8 Dewar Course (Reverse), Any Sight – 20 shots A-25; 20 shots A-23  
Match No. 9 40 shots, 50 Meters reduced for 50 Yards Any Sights – A-27 Target  
Match No. 10 40 shots, 50 Yards Any Sights – A-23 Target

Match No. 11 Regional Any Sight Championship  
Total of Matches 6, 7, 8, 9

Match No. 12 Regional Championship – Grand Aggregate  
Total of Matches 5 and 11

### **TEAM MATCHES**

*2 Person team match with each competitor firing the Dewar Course, 20 shots, Any Sights – A-23/5 Target and 20 shots A-25 Target. Firing will commence upon completion of Metallic Sight Matches on Saturday.*

Match No. 6 Any Sight Team Match

**AWARDS:** 1<sup>st</sup> Place – Medal  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place – Medal with 3 or more teams  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place – Medal with 5 or more teams

**RANGE FACILITIES:** AR&PC has 36 covered firing points. Lightweight wooden target frames are used. Limited camping facilities are available with water & electric hook-ups, and indoor restrooms but no showers.

**MOTELS/RESTAURANTS:** There are many motels and restaurants within 20 minutes of the range.

**PRACTICE:** Any shooter wishing to practice on Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup> should contact Doug Wall in advance to arrange to have the range open. Targets will be available.

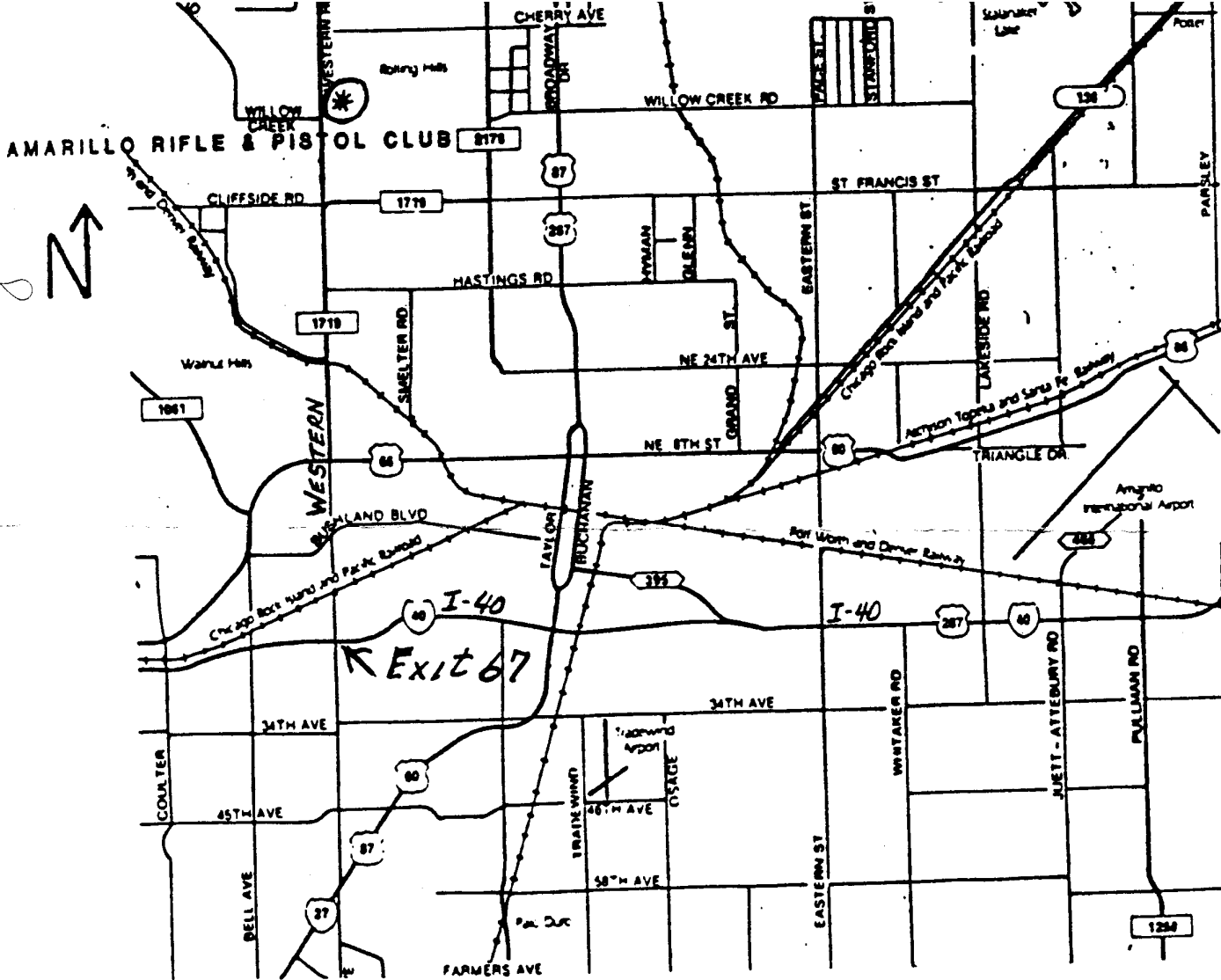
**FOOD/BEVERAGE:** Plan on bringing your own food and beverage as only water is available at the club house.
