Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club will be hosting a <u>3-Position & Prone</u> Smallbore Rifle fun-match on Saturday, <u>APRIL 4, 2020</u>. This match is set up to help with the daily cost of maintaining club property and helping to fund further upkeep and improvements to gun ranges. This match is also a great way for 4-H'rs and their parents to get used to and prepare for match conditions similar to the upcoming 4-H district match.

Entry Fees: \$5.00 for youths \$10.00 for adults/parents

Participants: 4H & Youth Rifle Shooters and parents/friends (open to all capable shooting enthusiasts)

Rifle: Any .22 caliber long rifle – single shot bolt action **Ammunition:** Please provide your own ammunition.

Sights: Any iron, open, or peep sights

Rules: Current NRA Rifle rules will govern.

Course of Fire: 10 shots in each position: prone, standing, & kneeling for 4-H'rs

& anyone who wants to try shooting all <u>3 positions</u>.

Course of Fire: 30 shots in prone position for 4-H'rs and anyone who would like to try just prone position.

Preparation Time: Please arrive at the range at least 30 minutes before desired firing time.

8:00 a.m. – Prone only
10:30 a.m. – Prone only
11:30 a.m. – 3 Position
1:00 p.m. – Prone only
2:00 p.m. – 3 Position

3:30 p.m. – 3 Position 5:30 p.m. – Offhand Shoot-Out These times and relays are subject to change depending on the number of shooters.

Finals: All participants and spectators are invited to attend and "yell for or boo" for their favorite shooters. Bring your bells, whistles, and any kind of noise maker. The top 10 standing target scores will be eligible for the shoot-off, if willing and able. If not, we will go down the list of standing scores to get at least 10 shooters for the finals, fired in the standing position, so please call and find out if you are to participate in the finals shoot-off.
