When is vendor set up?

Vendors are allowed in the park the day before the show starts. This year it's Wednesday, July 3rd.

Vendors can arrive between 9am until 5pm. If accommodations are needed for late set up, please let us know.

Where do I go when I arrive?

Vendors will come in Skyline Dr, Worcester MA. Proceed to the red Show Office Trailer. A show representative will check you in and direct you to your assigned vendor spot. You will be allowed to drive to your spot to unload tables / tents / etc. You do not have to set up product. Product can be set up between 6am-8am each day. All vendor booths must be open for 8am. General Show admission will open at 9am daily.

When are the show hours?

Thurs -July 4th: 6am – 8am: Vendor Daily Prep

9am – 4pm Green Hill Park Show

Fri – July 5th : 6am - 8am: Vendor Daily Prep

9am – 4pm Green Hill Park Show

Sat – July 6th: 6am – 8am: Vendor Daily Prep

9am – 3pm: Green Hill Park Show

2pm – 3pm: Trophies given out at 2pm. Break down starts at 3pm.

Coming & Going?

Fairgoers expect to find and enjoy the activities and events we have advertised. You must not break down your display before advertised closing time.

Rain or Shine?

Cars of Summer is held rain or shine. There will be no refunds for any reason. New England weather is unpredictable but the show must go on – come prepared.

Can I put up a pop up tent?

Tents must be 20x20 or smaller. Any tents larger than this need to apply for a permit from the Worcester Inspectional Services. We recommend using multiple smaller tents vs 1 large tent. Your tents must be weighted down. We do not provided weights on site.

Can I stake in the ground?

No. There are electrical wires and underground irrigation pipes throughout the park. No stakes can be driven into the ground. All tents must be secured by weights, sand bags, water barrels, or whatever you choose to weigh down the tents. Any tents not secured will be asked to be taken down. Tents that fall over or move as a result of wind are subject to damages paid at your expense. There is a Lowe's around the corner if supplies need to be purchased.

How do I get to the show?

There are two entrances. Vendors, Flea Market, and show cars will come through 50 Skyline Dr, Worcester MA. Spectators and show cars will also come through Green Hill Parkway, Worcester MA Entrance.

Are there policy and/or security on site?

We will have onsite policy and security starting Wednesday, July 3rd. They are onsite to help in the event of an emergency for our overnight campers and staff. Although they are onsite, you are responsible for securing your products. Tents and tables can be left up but any products left unsecured are at your own risk. The park is shut down with police at each entrance however the park sits along neighborhoods in the city. We have had people walk into the park through the wood line. If you should see someone in the park, not marked with a staff shirt, police uniform, security shirt, or camper lanyards, please tell the onsite security.

Who is my contact person once I arrive?

The event coordinator is Marissa Brown. Additional core staff that will be onsite to assist you are Gary Cooper or Stan Carpenter. We will have unique staff shirts and will be on golf carts around the park. You can reach out to any staff member with a radio to request a staff member to your location.

Can I bring a golf cart?

The only golf carts allowed onsite are for staff only or handicap with placard and proof of insurance.

How much does it cost?

Spectator are \$10 a day with kids under 12 years admitted free with paid adult.

Show cars are \$25 a day or \$45 for 3 days, comes with two admissions.

Can I park my car in my spot?

No. There will be parking near the flea market for vendor vehicles that are not approved as part of your display.

Can I sell whatever I want?

Products must have been preapproved. New items must be approved prior to sale. All items must be in good taste as this is family friend event.

What other things will be at the show?

We will have over 1,000 show cars come into the park. There will also be 4 live bands, food court, kid zone with bounce houses, costume characters, onsite petting zoo, onsite 18 hole golf course, interactive games, raffles, and trophies.

Is electricity available?

There is no electricity available. Please plan accordingly.

Is Subletting or Share Spaces allowed?

Subletting/Sharing of space is prohibited.

Balloon Sales/Raffles/Drawing:

Un-approved balloon sales or giveaways are prohibited. All raffles, drawings, etc., free or otherwise, must be preapproved by Event Coordinator.

Are Pets / Bicycles / Scooters allowed?

No they are prohibited within show grounds. Dogs are allowed but must be leashed and picked up after.

Trash:

You must leave your space as you found it. You are responsible for hauling away your own trash. There is a dumpster onsite available for show vendors. Vendors are required to put your trash in the dumpster.

Space Location

Cars of Summer reserves the right to relocate any exhibitor as needed.

Badges / Vehicle Placards / Staff Bracelets:

Commercial vendors will be issued vendor placards and bracelets. These packets are issued prior to the event. Packets can also be picked up at Brook Motors, 603 Southbridge St, Auburn MA or at the park the day of your set up at the Show Office on-site. These packets gives you entrance to the show for all 3 days. Additional vendor badges will be sold at the discretion of the COS coordinator at the rate of \$5 per day.

Camping on site:

There is camping available on site. Space is limited so spots must be reserved prior to the show. There are no hook ups. All units must be self contained. There are port-a-potties on site but no shower or washing facilities. There are no open fires. You may use a grill. Campers will be issued special placards and passes. Passes must be worn after show hours. Visitors are not allowed on site after hours. Campers will have access to come and go as needed but will need provide proof of ID and check in with security at the gates. We ask that you respect other campers on site and offer quieter hours after 10pm. Campers are not allowed to roam the park after hours and must keep to the camping areas. Cars of Summer reserves the right to revoke camping priviledges based on management / security discretion.
