Instruments are not provided by the school but can be either purchased or rented from a music store. Attached is a list of all of the local music stores where instruments and supplies can be found. It is imperative that students have the correctly sized instrument. Students can be sized for an instrument at your local music store or by me.

If your child is interested in cello, please be aware that the official policy for Chesapeake Public Schools is that cellos are **not** allowed on the buses. Students are required to take their instruments home to practice so that they can excel and feel good about their playing.

If you are interested in purchasing an instrument, please be sure to look for quality. Some of the really cheap instruments end up costing far more because of the cost of maintenance and repairs. This includes colored instruments (pink, blue etc.) It is also much harder to make these instruments sound good which can be frustrating for the students. If you have any questions about the quality of an instrument, please feel free to send me an e-mail prior to purchase and I will give you my honest opinion.

If students want to be in orchestra in the 6^{th} grade they must be in 5^{th} grade strings or they will have to audition in 6^{th} grade. We will have two performances this year.

Strings class meets twice a week on **Tuesdays** and **Fridays** during normal school hours.

Students must have their instruments in class by **September 22nd**.

Practice:
