





Aim

The aim of the weekend is to bring together brethren, sisters and young people/children of like mind to study the Word of Life and to enjoy fellowship.

Venue

The venue is the Pioneer Conference Centre in Cleobury Mortimer, near Kidderminster. It is set in beautiful surroundings, is spacious and has suitable accommodation. All rooms will have en-suite facilities, with some rooms being suitable for the disabled. The rooms consist of 2,3,4 and 5 beds. All our meals will be provided for as well as refreshments.

Within each accommodation block there are lounges which are for general use, and would be ideal for mums of little children to congregate in the evenings, whilst their children are asleep in their rooms. Mums may wish to bring a baby monitor.

Young People

The children and young people will have their own studies and will be divided up into ages 0-6, 7-10 and 11-16 years. They will each have studies under a general theme of "The Exodus".

Activities

On Saturday afternoon there is free time with activities such as sports (with exclusive use of a sports hall), games, crafts, country walk (weather permitting) and a daily readings session. There is also a bookshop with Christadelphian Scripture Study Service books as well as other books available.

Cost and Deposit

The cost of the whole weekend (incl. accommodation and food) is as follows:-

Please note, there is a single room supplement charge of £10 for those single people who would like a room of their own.

We will require a deposit of £25 per adult and £5 each for those aged 4-16 (maximum of £60 deposit per family). The balance will need to be paid by 9th October 2018.
