We have been making a lot of friends here, especially at the nearby orphanage. We love orphans! What is it about them? They are incredibly fun to be around.





With the generous support from you guys, we have been able to finish the Lipa Christian Church's window security bars and the electrical. We also bought 150 chairs and have started the installation of 2 doors. This section of the church will be ready to open very soon. Open Door Christian Academy (the orphanage that we have been helping) is in need of a few things. The government does not help orphanages here. They need 12 mattresses, sheets, and pillows. Several kids have to sleep together. Also, they need new computers for their library. They only have 3 old computers for about 190 students. Let us know if you want to help with this project.
