Tournament News — 2015

Congratulations to our U13A Tournament team that took out the trophies at the Blaze Club Tournament competition. On a day that challenged many players (and clubs) Adam and the girls went through the day undefeated. Our other teams had mixed results, but enjoyed the tournament style day.

And preparations are well underway for the second tournament of 2015, the Banyule Club Tournament.

LNC has entered 6 teams again in this competition including two Under 11 teams, two Under 13 teams, and one Under 15 and one Under 17 team.

And the club committee decided to order a larger 6m x 3m tent recognising that the extra teams at tournament filled the two 3m x 3m offering at Diamond Creek. We are hoping for better weather, but expect to set up all of these tents on the day at Banyule to cater for our increased club presence.

The development squad training program will kick off again on Monday nights at Hazel Glen College Gymnasium in the school holidays and will continue for the 4 weeks leading up to the tournament. The first of these sessions will be on Monday 29th June. The sessions will move back to Laurimar PS after the holidays.

Age group will train according to the following timetable.

U11's: 5.30—6.30pm, U13's: 6.00—7.30pm, U15's & U17's: 7.00—8.30pm.

All players are invited to development squad training from which the tournament teams will be selected.
