**Directions:**

1. Open a blank document in **Word 2016**.
2. Go to File and Save As "**EscapeGameYourName.**"
3. Make sure to **center** your text at the top of the page.
4. In Large Text (or WORD ART), type the title of your game. (Theme)
5. Go to Top Tool Bar and click on **Insert** tab, then click on **Table**.  
Select a 2x2 Table. (That's two rows, two columns.) \*See example next page.
6. Type in a number for each section (cell) of Table. Each number will represent the room# to escape. \*See example next page.
7. Each room must have the following: \*See example next page.
  - Description of Setting in Room
  - 3 or more items needed to escape the room
  - Description of how someone uses each item to escape the room.
  - Pictures of each of the 3 or more items
  - USE DIFFERENT ITEMS IN EACH ROOM (LEVEL).\*\*\*\*\*If you know how, add a different color to each table cell.
8. Save your document often.
