Re-registration Packet 2019 – 2020

Dear Parents:

Re-registration for the 2019 - 2020 school year will begin on December 3, 2018. We had our largest enrollment for the 2018-2019 school term of 1,104 students. We are continually blessed and thankful for your constant prayers throughout the school year.

The re-registration fee of \$200.00 per student is due Friday, January 18th. The re-registration fee cannot be paid online through Headmaster. The payment must accompany the required paperwork listed below.

The following forms will need to be completed and returned with your re-registration payment:

- Statement of Cooperation (requires parents' signatures)
- Parent's Pledge of Acceptance (requires parents' signature)
- Standard of Conduct for 6th - 12th grade students only (requires parent's & student's signatures)

New PreK Sibling Packet: All required paperwork for PreK sibling enrollment must be picked up in the Elementary / Business Office. To register for PreK, the student must be 4 years old before September 30, 2019. We begin enrollment for new PreK siblings on December 3, 2018. Therefore, it is important that all paperwork and the \$350 registration fee be turned into the school office as soon as possible. Admission for a PreK sibling is not guaranteed.

New Kindergarten - 12th Sibling: All required paperwork for a new student in Kindergarten - 12th grade must be picked up in the Elementary / Business office. To register for Kindergarten, the student must be 5 years old before September 30, 2019. Notifications of acceptance begin in the month of February. The \$350 registration fee is due upon acceptance. The student is not considered enrolled until the registration fee is paid.

All paperwork required for a new student enrollment is available in the Elementary Business office or on LCA's website under Admissions. Re-registration rates will increase to \$350.00 per child after the deadline on January 18, 2019. Re-registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

The administration would like to emphasize the importance of returning the enclosed forms and payment prior to Friday, January 18th. Classroom enrollment has limited availability in most grade levels. Registration will be opened to new families on February 1st. Late re-registration paperwork and payment may result in your student being placed in a waiting pool rather than on a classroom roster.

TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE 2019 - 2020

Re-registration Fee:

The non-refundable, non-transferable re-registration fee of **\$200** per student is to be paid by **Friday, January 18, 2019**. Late re-registration paperwork and payment may result in your student being placed in a waiting pool rather than on a classroom roster. The late re-registration fee increases to \$350.00 per child after the deadline on January 18, 2019. Re-registration fees cannot be added to your tuition account and cannot be paid online.

Please return the attached paperwork and the re-registration fee to the Elementary Business Office or mail to Lafayette Christian Academy, 220 Portland Avenue, Lafayette, LA 70507.

Tuition:

- Please see the chart below for the tuition rate breakdown for the 2019 – 2020 school year. If you are delinquent with your June payment, the enrollment slot in that grade level will be opened to new students.
- Beginning June 1, 2019, all credit card payments will have a convenience fee added to each transaction.
- We do offer a 5% discount on prepaid annual tuition if paid between May 1st - May 17th by check or cash only.
- A family discount is available for three students at a 10% discount, four students at a 20% discount, and a 30% discount for five or more children. There is no discount available for 1 or 2 students.
- Special rates are given to The Family Church titheers.

Curriculum Fees:

The Curriculum Fee includes: book rental, yearbook, planner if applicable, activity fee (includes free admission into ALL LCA home games with student ID, excludes LHSAA Playoffs), spirit day participation, and supports clubs and organizations on campus. All textbooks are the property of Lafayette Christian Academy and are to be returned to the school at the end of the school year or at the time of student transfer.

- PreK & Kindergarten \$320 (includes some supplies)
- 1st - 3rd Grade \$375 (includes some supplies)
- 4th - 6th Grades \$320
- 7th - 12th Grades \$395

Additional Fees:

These additional fees will be invoiced on the monthly tuition statement, if applicable.

- Lunch Program
- Graduation Fees
- For 7th - 12th, a School I.D. Fee of \$10 is billed at the beginning of school.
- Athletic Fees will be billed during the season played.
- Early Care and/or Beyond the Bell After Care are charged at the time of service and will be invoiced on the tuition statement.

STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

It is my understanding that registration fees are non-refundable. I give Lafayette Christian Academy permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including school-sponsored trips away from the school premises. I also believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student, as well as for the entire school. I give permission for my child's teacher and/or other agent of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures. I hereby grant Lafayette Christian Academy permission to use my child's likeness, photograph, video, or other digital media in any and all of its publications, including web-based publications, without payment or other consideration. I further agree to hold the school and its agents harmless for any liability to my child or any guardian or parent thereof, because of an injury to my child. Should action, for any reason, be taken on my child's behalf against Lafayette Christian Academy or any employee or agent thereof, and the school and its agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay any fees, damages, or other costs that Lafayette Christian Academy or its agent should incur to defend itself.

This Statement of Cooperation will be in effect for as long as my children listed below (or others to be enrolled) attend Lafayette Christian Academy whether it is PreK, Kindergarten, Elementary, Junior High, and/or Senior High.

The designated guardians accountable to the school are to be the only persons the school will be accountable to unless the designated guardians allow another party, by written notice to the school principal, to act on his or her behalf.

If parent(s) marital status or guardianship changes, it is my responsibility to notify Lafayette Christian Academy. At that time, a corrected Statement of Cooperation will need to be submitted. Lafayette Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin.

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PARENT’S PLEDGE OF ACCEPTANCE

We, as parents who are accepting the challenge to “train up a child in the way he should go” (Proverbs 22:6), do state that this training will be carried on in the home. We shall place our trust in Lafayette Christian Academy to extend that training more completely.

We, as parents/guardians, agree to represent Lafayette Christian Academy well in word and deed. If my behavior is out of line with LCA standards, I understand LCA reserves the right to remove my child from enrollment.

We pledge that, if for any reason, our child does not respond favorably to the school, we will not try to change the school to fit his needs but will withdraw him quietly and without delay. (Six weeks are adequate for most students. The student who has not adjusted by the end of nine weeks should be withdrawn).

We hereby grant authority to Lafayette Christian Academy to discipline our child as necessary. We further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child in the home as needed.

We pledge our loyal support to the school through praying for its programs, participating in school fundraisers as we are able, and by paying the tuition payment regularly and on time.

We contractually agree to pay the tuition according to arrangements that shall be made. We understand that my family account and student records must be current for report cards and transcripts to be issued. School records will be forwarded to another school only when a family account is current.

STANDARD OF CONDUCT & HONOR CODE (6TH – 12TH GRADE ONLY)

Upon entering school, students are expected to maintain the highest standards of integrity, honesty, and morality. Further development of responsible behavior is a basic tenet of the Standard of Conduct and Honor Code pledges. Students will exhibit a good appearance at all times. Both dress and behavior should exemplify the high standards of Christian example. Students should exercise good taste and dress appropriately. A person’s conduct should never be an embarrassment to others.

The Standard of Conduct & Honor Code based on the following Biblical imperatives are necessary to provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people. All of the activities of the Christian must be subordinated to the glory of God who indwells us. The Christian will endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of the world and loss of the Christian’s physical, mental, or spiritual well being. A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led LCA to adopt the following standards which it is believed are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the student.

Honor Code: Out of a desire to honor God, I commit to a lifestyle which reflects trust, honesty, and respect for my peers, authority, and all property. I acknowledge this lifestyle does not condone lying, cheating, stealing, profanity, and other dishonorable acts. Committing to this code demonstrates my respect for Lafayette Christian Academy as we strive to glorify God and love others.

Standard of Conduct: The school requires each student to refrain from any form of smoking including e-cigarettes and vaping; using vulgar language; drinking alcoholic beverages; entering bars, clubs, or similar settings such as a party that alcohol is present; engaging in sexual immoral activities; using illegal drugs; and attending dances that are not sponsored by a school. Students are not allowed to attend parties where underage drinking is occurring. Body piercing and tattoos are NOT permitted. Males are prohibited from wearing earrings on campus or at school functions. Standard of Conduct is in effect as long as the student is enrolled at LCA, regardless of time, place, or circumstances. Violations will result in suspension or expulsion.

The Standard of Conduct and Honor Code reflects the philosophy of LCA, excellent education without compromising the Word of God. Students are strongly encouraged to be sure they understand what the Standard of Conduct and Honor Code expect and be sure they want to follow the lifestyle presented. LCA administrators are serious about upholding their part. When students and parents sign the Standard of Conduct and Honor Code, they are accepting the principles expressed. These principles are not considered negotiable.

The selection of the restrictions mentioned in the pledge may appear arbitrary to some. While not condemning others who see differently, LCA believes that the restrictions named are outstanding types of conduct that are detrimental to the student’s spiritual growth, which is our objective. Students found to be out of harmony with the LCA ideals of life may be invited to withdraw when the general welfare demands it, even though there may be no special breach of conduct.

I have read the Standard of Conduct and Honor Code and while enrolled at LCA agree to cooperate with these standards to the fullest extent. I will submit myself to the leadership of LCA and/or any rules or regulations that may be adopted or changed from time to time. I realize that my attendance at LCA is a privilege and not a right. I determine to give my best and to prayerfully support LCA and its philosophy.
