

# Certificate II in Process Plant Operations

National Course Code: **PMA20116**

## Career outcome

This qualification has been specifically developed to provide training for people pursuing employment in the oil and gas industry. It will provide participants who successfully complete the course with basic skills that would support their initial employment in the oil and gas industry. The training will be conducted in the purpose built On Shore Petroleum Centre of Excellence (OPCE) located at TAFE SA Tonsley.

## Course content

This broad qualification will provide a practical skills foundation to prepare an individual for a range of tasks commonly undertaken in the hydrocarbons sector involving plant operations.

Course content includes:

- > Operate and monitor prime movers
- > Gas test atmospheres
- > Work in accordance with an issue permit
- > Monitor wells and gathering systems
- > Operate separation equipment
- > Prepare and isolate plant
- > Read dials and indicators
- > Break and make flanged joints using hand tools
- > Participate in environmentally sustainable work practices
- > Follow emergency response procedures
- > Work safely
