KNITTING FOR NKHOMA, MALAWI

David and Rebecca have just visited Gordon Presbytery. They spoke of the value of our knitting and sewing to the people in Nkhoma. Not only are we helping people who come to the hospital but also the ten rural clinics which they support. Rebecca told us that another 20 boxes of knitting have recently arrived. Another 23 boxes were taken to Dundee which were sent out with the Raven Trust at the beginning of September.
