HOTEL DESCRIPTION

Three refurbished historical homes, each over 100 years old, mark the bygone colonial era of Luang Prabang, blending vintage French architecture and classic Lao design. Surrounded by lush, wooded hills at the confluence of the Nam Khan and Mekong Rivers, the hotel embodies a touch of mythological lure, nagas being fabled serpent spirits protecting the ancient town. The property's elegant beauty is enhanced with exotic wood flooring, traditional 'torchis' walls and clay roof tiles. Located on the central heritage street of Luang Prabang, guests can enjoy glimpses of authentic local culture and tradition, such as Buddhist monks passing the hotel as they collect morning alms. 3 Nagas is an inviting destination for history and culture enthusiasts.

ROOM DESCRIPTION

Fifteen impressively spacious rooms, sized between 30 and 56 sqm, open out onto a beautiful garden adjacent the Nam Khan River or overlook the quaint town of Luang Prabang. Colonial furniture amidst traditional Lao design adds warmth and atmosphere to each room.

Exuding authenticity and charm, the 15 guest rooms are split between the Lamache House, shaded by mango trees, and the Khamboua House, found on the opposite side of the street. Offering 12 Deluxe rooms and 3 Executive suites, each room is well-appointed with comfort and grace, complimented by an attached terrace or balcony, Wi-Fi, coffee and tea making facilities, minibar and an in-room safety deposit box.

3 NAGAS RESTAURANT

A fine-dining establishment specialising in exquisite Lao cuisine, made with fresh ingredients sourced from local farms. Open from 06:30 until 22:30, the award-winning restaurant serves rave-worthy fare. The indoor bistro setting is a cosy place to pass a warm afternoon, while the opposing al fresco courtyard is impeccable for soaking up Luang Prabang's surreal evening atmosphere.



THE 3 NAGAS GARDEN

Covering 500 sqm, this outdoor garden oasis, one of the last of its kind in Luang Prabang, borders the Nam Khan River. The scenic central pond is under UNESCO's protection and is kept remote by a picket fence. Guests will appreciate a wide selection of literature from our library or enjoy an intimate candle-lit dinner in this old-town sanctuary.

VINTAGE AUTOMOBILE TRANSFERS

The charming cream-coloured 1956 Mercedes-Benz or dark-crimson 1952 Citroen are available to book for tours of Luang Prabang or airport transfers.

EXTENDED SERVICES AVAILABLE AT SOFITEL LUANG PRABANG

Located five-minutes by car or a brisk 20 minute walk away, Sofitel shares its Spa, a haven of relaxation offering botanic beauty rituals and indigenous healing techniques, with guests of 3 Nagas. Guests can also partake in an insightful introductory cooking class covering the culinary traditions of Laos, as well as enjoy the 25-metre swimming pool and lounge area.

MEMORABLE MOMENT

An on-site cooking lesson links guests to the hotel's roots as the royal ice cream factory, prefaced by a trip to the colourful morning market.
