Canada and the USA

In 2017 we aim to raise the profile of the Choir further by touring Canada and the USA; we feel that this will provide us with the opportunity to promote both the Chapel Choir and Hatfield College on an international level.

Between 24th March and 4th April 2017, the Choir will travel to Canada and the USA. They will perform in some of the best venues that these cities have to offer. Their current engagements are:

- Concert on 25th April at St John's, Lunenburg, NS
- Eucharist on 26th March and a concert at All Saints Cathedral, Halifax, NS
- Concert on 28th March at the Cathedral of All Saints, Albany, NY
- Two services on Sunday 2nd April at St James Cathedral, Toronto, ON – including a joint evensong with the Cathedral Choir

There will also be opportunities to explore some of the greatest sights in these cities, including:

- Niagara Falls
- CN Tower
- Air Canada Centre
- Alexander Keith's Brewery
- USS Slater

This is a tour that will enable members of the Chapel Choir to showcase some of the musical highlights of the College whilst exploring some of Canada and USA's own cultural highlights.
