Levi has a real love for the Ni-vans and is excited about getting back there as soon as possible to minister alongside Matthew & Lydia Meads, his brother-in-law and sister, and Jeremy & Liz Pinero. His fellow laborers are anxious to get Levi back. He speaks Bislama, the trade language, and has done interpreting, preaching, led in Bible studies, and helped in church planting.

God has equipped Levi so that he is a real asset on the mission field. He is a graduate of Faith Bible Institute of Monroe, Louisiana, and is perhaps the most diversified missionary I have ever known. He has been blessed with mechanical, heavy equipment operations, welding, electrical, plumbing, carpentry, concrete, masonry, and computer technological skills. On a field where fording rapid rivers without bridges and negotiating rugged to no roads to reach the people and where skilled labor and parts are scarce to null, a missionary needs abilities to keep vehicles and equipment running.

Levi's ingenuity and improvisation have proved invaluable, saving much time and money. Levi's and Jenn's heart to reach the people plus their skills help make the outreach possible.
