

Felt Calla Lilies
Abby's Attic Sewing & Crafting Studio, 2017

Materials:

Felt scraps larger than 4"x4"

Green chenille stems (pipe cleaners)

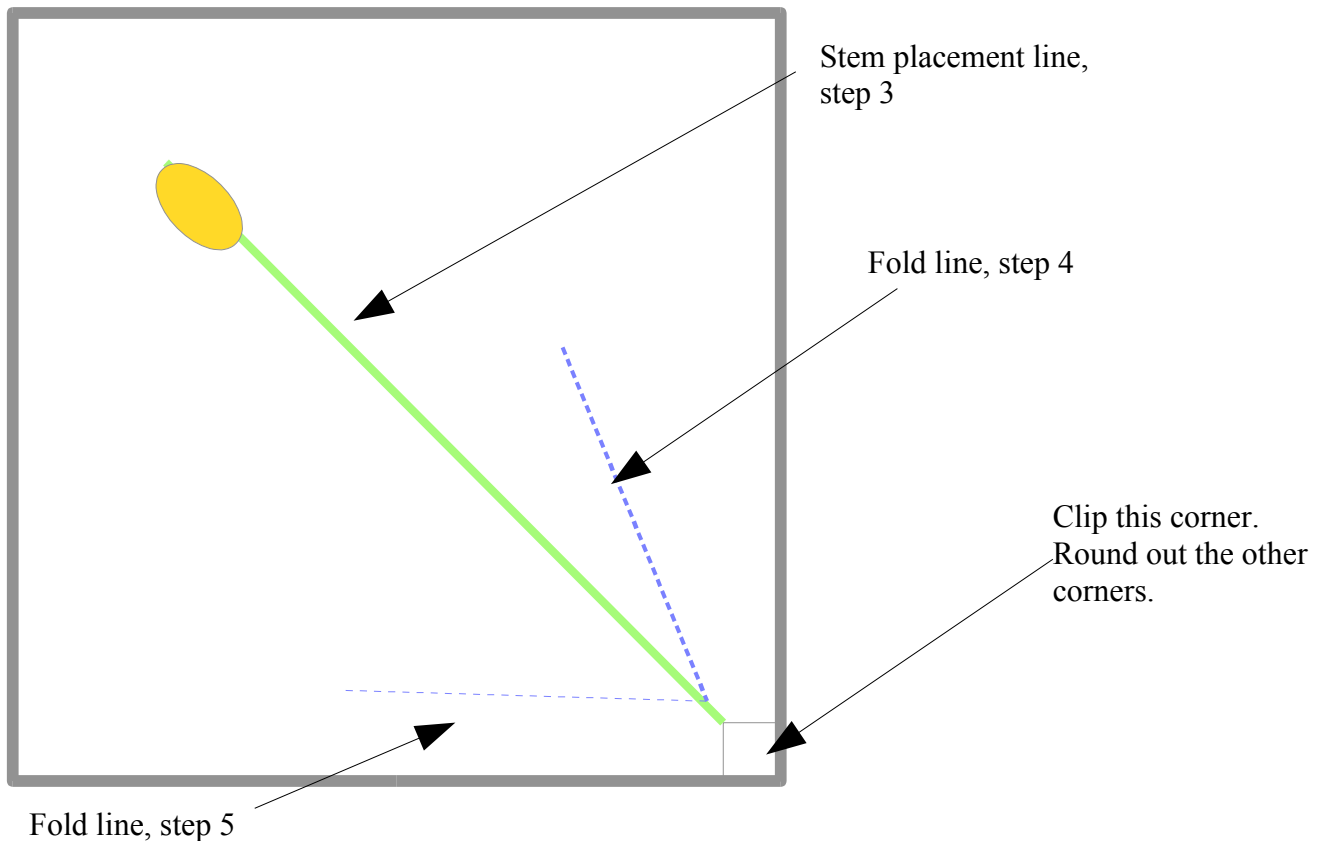
Yellow chenille "bump" stems (pipe cleaners)

Glue gun and glue sticks

Scissors

Directions:

1. Cut a 4"x4" square from your felt. Round out 3 of the corners by trimming a curve. Cut a "v" into the 4th corner.
2. Clip off one "bump" from the yellow chenille stem and twist it onto one end of a green chenille stem.
3. Position the stem so that the green stem is on the "v" corner and the yellow "pollen" is about 1" from the opposite corner. Glue down about 2" of the stem to the felt.
4. Using the folding lines on the template provided, fold over the left edge and glue to secure.
5. Fold over the right edge and glue about 2" up the bottom of the flower to secure.
6. Allow to cool before proceeding. It might help to place something heavy on the folds until they cool so they stay together.
7. Repeat as many time as your heart desires and enjoy the compliments you will receive!
