

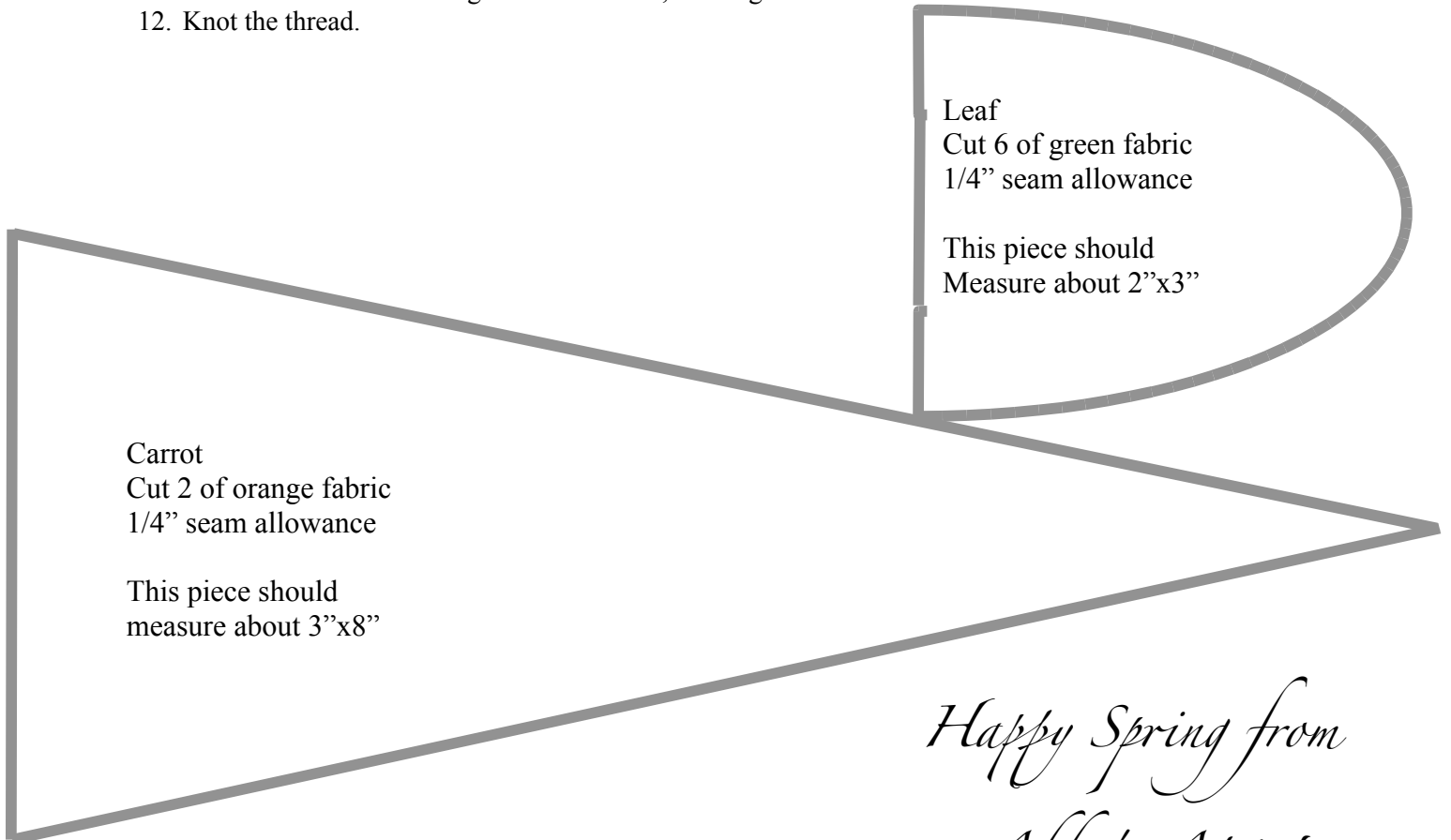
Fabric Carrots
Abby's Attic Sewing & Crafting Studio, 2017

Materials:

Scrap of orange fabric (at least 7"x 8")
Scrap of orange fabric (at least 9"x9" or 3"x19")
Needle & thread to match fabrics, glue gun or sewing machine
Polyfil or cotton balls
Printable pattern (below)
Iron

Directions:

1. Cut TWO orange triangles using the "carrot" pattern piece.
2. Cut SIX green cup-shaped pieces using the "leaf" pattern piece.
3. Place the triangles right sides together. Sew with a 1/4" seam allowance along the two longest edges. Alternatively, glue the pieces together along the two longest edges.
4. Clip off the tip but do not cut the stitches!
5. Turn carrot right side out.
6. Place two green pieces right sides together and sew along the curved edge with a 1/4" seam allowance, leaving the short straight edge open.
7. Turn and press flat. Repeat with the other green pieces. You will now have three "leaves."
8. Stuff the carrot with polyfil or cotton balls.
9. Fold the raw edge toward the inside of the carrot about 1/8" down. Sew a running stitch by hand all the way around the opening for a gathering stitch.
10. Tuck your three leaves into the opening and pull the gathering threads tight to close the opening.
11. Sew back and forth through all thicknesses, securing the leaves to the inside of the carrot.
12. Knot the thread.
