A paralegal is a person qualified by education, training or work experience who is employed or retained by a lawyer, law office, corporation, governmental agency or other entity and who performs specifically delegated substantive legal work for which a lawyer is responsible.

ACTIVE (VOTING) MEMBER: Any individual who meets at least one of the following requirements may become an Active, voting member of LPA.

- 1. Any individual who has graduated from an <u>American Bar Association (ABA)</u> approved program of study, including a law school, who is working as a paralegal. Please review the ABA Approved Paralegal Programs Directory to see if your Paralegal Program was ABA Approved: <u>https://www.americanbar.org/groups/paralegals/</u>. If you went to law school please confirm if your law school was ABA approved.
- 2. Any individual who has graduated from a course of study for paralegals which requires not less than 60 <u>semester hours</u> of classroom study. (<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: a semester hour *IS NOT* a normal 60 minute hour, it is a unit of academic credit representing an hour of class).
- 3. Any individual who has attained a nationally recognized <u>paralegal certification</u> (NOT a certificate), whose certification remains valid. (<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: It is important to distinguish between a paralegal certificate and certification. The student is now certificated in paralegal studies. A certified paralegal is one that has successfully completed a certification exam or other requirements of the certifying organization.)
- 4. Any retired individual who has been an ACTIVE member of LPA for at least five (5) years and who has either attained the age of 55 years or received mandatory retirement because of physical disability and who provides evidence of a minimum of five (5) hours of continuing legal education within the immediately preceding year.
