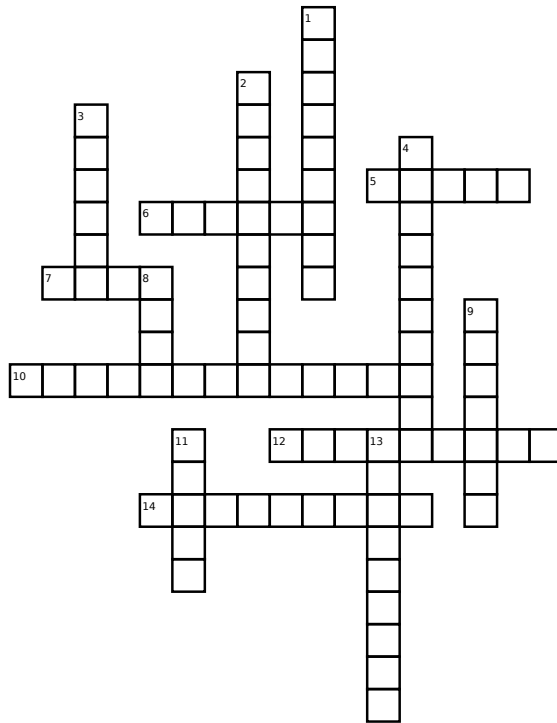


Jazz Vocabulary



Down:

1. a ballet term meaning to beat but also known as a kick
2. four steps in a square pattern
3. a series of turns
4. a weight transfer on the ball of the foot
8. bending of the knees
9. a kick that circles 360 degrees
11. a sassy way of "flicking" an arm or a foot
13. a turn on the ball of the foot

Across:

5. means to pass and one foot makes a triangle shape against the other knee
6. to chase
7. a split position in the air from one leg to the other
10. a turn done in a straight line using 3 steps
12. a step side, step front, step side, step back
14. rotating on an axis without traveling
