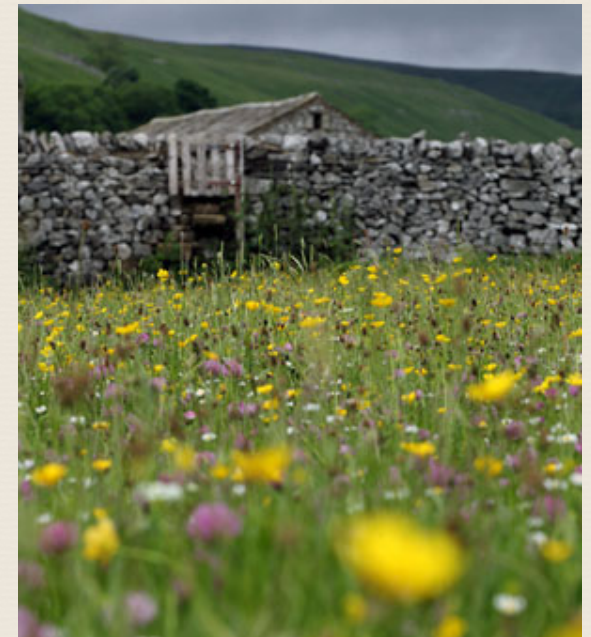

## CLIFF'S CORNER



In Acts 1:8 Jesus says, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

What Jesus says here is an incredible statement of our main purpose as His followers, that is to be witnesses for Jesus. The mandate He has given us is not haphazard but very purposeful in that we are to take the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to our neighbours, to our immediate community, to our nation and to the nations of the earth.

What is so striking about this verse is that we are to do it all simultaneously, in other words, it's not about prioritising one group over another. Jesus has always seen the mission of the Church not as 'either/or' (either neighbours or nations) but rather as 'both/and' (reaching both our neighbours and the nations together). This is obviously done under the leading of the Holy Spirit as He leads and guides us with the specifics.

There will also continue to be amazing opportunities where we get to reach people in different nations, like Indonesia and the Solomon Islands.

I would like to leave us all with the words of Psalm 16:5-7, which says,
