

Lady Select Sports Program, Code of Conduct

To ensure safe, supportive and respectful sports programs, the Lady Select will have a zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike behaviors of patrons, participants, coaches and fans.

The Department's Code of Conduct requires that participants in Sports Programs (with or without a reasonable accommodation) conduct themselves in a rational and reasonable manner, in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the LADY SELECT.

Unsportsmanlike behaviors exhibited by patrons, participants, coaches and fans will not be tolerated. Failure to abide by the terms of the Code of Conduct may result in notification of the local authorities and/or expulsion or suspension from the Sport Programs.

- **Our goal** is to build a team of players that consistently demand more of themselves, than is demanded by the coaches. Be coachable, hustle, display mental toughness, and be focused on the game. **WE WILL WORK HARDER AND SMARTER THAN ANY OTHER TEAM.** We will strive to develop good habits by practicing with good form and appropriate efforts. "These efforts will determine our success during competitive play.
- **RESPECT COACHES, TEAMMATES, OPPONENTS, PARENTS, MANAGERS AND REFEREES.** Behavior that reflects negativity on players, coaches and referees will not be tolerated, e.g. lack of control or profanity. **RESPECT CLASSROOM TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATORS.** Lack of respect and discipline issues resulting in school consequences will result in game or team suspensions.
- **AS A LADY SELECT TEAM MEMBER, I WILL GO TO THE COACHES/ TEAM MEMBER FIRST IF THERE IS A PROBLEM, WHICH IS RELATED TO THE TEAM.** I will not complain to others, until I have given the person I have a problem with an opportunity to correct it; e.g., a team player or coach.
- **ADJUSTMENTS AND SACRIFICES** are necessary to achieve team and individual success. **EXTRAORDINARY COMMITMENT** on the part of players, their families, and the coaches is important. In return, we have an opportunity to create a positive experience that will affect our lives forever. No arguing with the official's decisions or calls. The Captains and/or Coaches may approach Officials for clarification of decisions only.
- **BE ON TIME FOR ALL GAMES AND PRESENT FOR ALL PRACTICES.** Be properly dressed with basketball shorts and shoes, no jewelry, phones, hair ware, etc. We are aware that there may be circumstances that arise that cause you to miss a practice; e.g. vacation, illness, etc. When this occurs, the

player or parent/guardian will inform their coach in advance when possible by updating our team communication application Team Snap or by sending an email to: administration@ladysselectball.com or to your respective Coach(es).

- **BEING GROUNDED BY YOUR PARENTS WILL BE TREATED AS AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE.** "Is type of absence will result in the player losing playing time and/or being dismissed from the team.
- **APPEARANCE/ HEALTH** When attending team functions, all players should be neat and well groomed. Hairstyle should be clean, combed and manageable. Clothing should clean, neat and be wrinkle free. No extreme styles.
- **APPLY GOOD HEALTHY HABITS.** "This includes 8 1/2 hours of sleep when possible. Eating breakfast, eating healthy foods, abstaining from excessive soda (12 oz per day maximum, none is better), and drinking at least 8 glasses of water per day.

Individuals may forfeit their privileges for failure to abide by the following:

- No person may interfere with any Commission employee acting in the course of his or her official duties.
- A person requested to leave the property by authorized personnel must do so immediately.
- The possession, use or distribution of weapons, instruments used as weapons, fireworks or explosives is prohibited.
- Fighting, theft and vandalism will not be tolerated.
- Refrain from indecent, obscene or hate language or conduct, including the use of profanity, derogatory gestures and intimidating comments.
- Physical or sexual assault, battery or improper touching will result in suspension and will be reported to the authorities.
- Possession, use or distribution of alcohol, illegal drugs or controlled dangerous substances is prohibited, as is the use of tobacco products in Commission facilities.
- Proper supervision and safety precautions will be taken at all times; however, the athlete participated at his/her own risk. LADY SELECT, or their employees will not assume liability for injury.

- Be patient with coaches who are not giving your child the playing time you feel he/she deserves.
- Respect that coaches will not discuss the game or your child immediately after a game.
- Agree to make all payments on time or be assessed late fees according to the rules.
- Late or non-payments renders player ineligible to participate at Lady Select events including but not limited to practice, games, workouts, etc.
- Participate in mandatory fundraisers sponsored by Lady Select or I can choose to pay a buyout fee of \$75 per fundraiser.
- I also understand that I am required to attend all parent meetings.
- I understand all of the rules of Lady Select and will adhere to all of the rules and policies therein.
- I understand that if I play on this team, I will agree to abide by these expectations.
- I have been informed of the required expectations during the basketball season.
- I will ensure that these expectations are realized.
