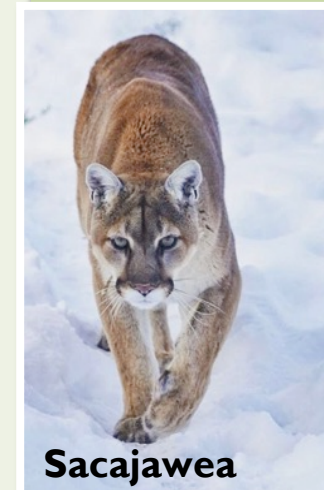

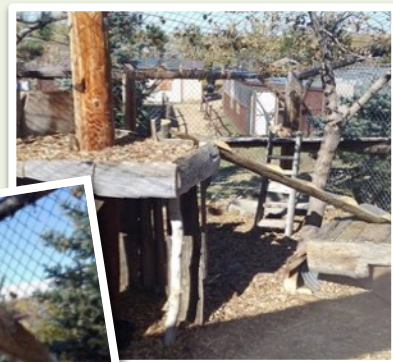
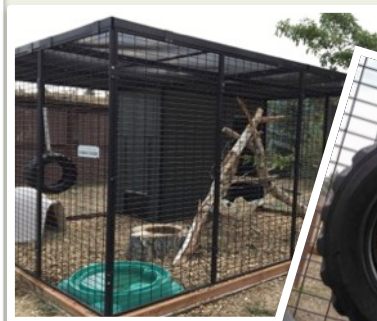


Completed Projects 2017

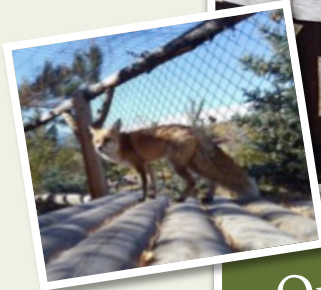


Our bear dens were all set for our hibernating bears this winter thanks to True North Steel and our volunteers. Winnie seems to approve (pictured left)!

The elk hill landscaping project is underway thanks to a grant from the Red Lodge Community Foundation and volunteers from the Montana Conservation Corp.
